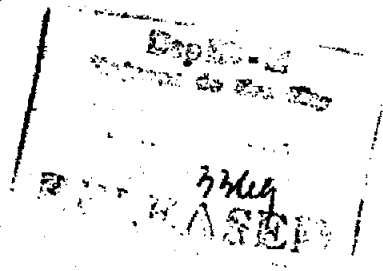

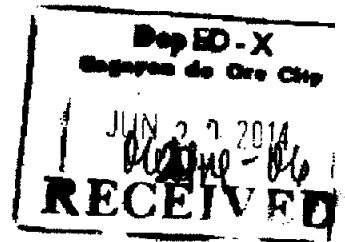


Greetings!

MECHANICS

1. Contest is open to all public elementary and high school teachers nationwide and will initially have a single category:

Essay in English for Elementary and High School Teachers

2. Each participant is required to submit only one (1) essay each
3. Contest will run from May 19, 2014 to August 30, 2014
4. Essays submitted should have the theme:

VALUE OF TEACHER'S HARD WORK AND DISCIPLINE IN THE CONTEXT OF TODAY'S EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS

5. Essays should be no less than 2,000 words and should not exceed 2,500 words
6. All submissions must be in computer printout (regular size white bond paper) using legible computer fonts (i.e. Times New Roman, Arial, Cambria);
7. Entries must be double-spaced with one-inch margins on both sides and top/bottom
8. Entries should be original and not have been previously entered in any contest or published—in part or in full—in any publication of local, regional, national and international circulation
9. All entries should be submitted by e-mail to:

10. Submitted essays should come with the filled-out Official Entry Form from the local/regional offices of the Department of Education (DepEd)
11. Entries will be judged on the basis of:
Mastery of Language (Grammar, spelling, etc.) - 40%
Originality/Creativity - 30%
Context/Substance- 30%
12. Chosen judges from each region will choose from the initial entries its best work (only one will be chosen). The chosen work will then represent the region during the finals. Chosen entries (finalists) will then be submitted to the main office of Fortune Life in Makati City.
13. Panel of judges for entries which will battle it out for the finals will be chosen from the editors of the *Philippines Graphic* magazine, members of the academe and the literary community

Teachers, Principals, Supervisors, Superintendents and DepEd Directors can nominate their candidates for the search of the 5 Awardees of the Gawad Parangal Ni Amb. Antonio Cabangon-Chua starting May 19, 2014 to August 30, 2014. Winners will be awarded on September ____, 2014 in Bulwagan ng Karunungan, Department of Education Central Office, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City.

Nominees must be a TEACHER, a PRINCIPAL or an EDUCATION SUPERVISOR of the schools registered with "The Values of Hardwork and Discipline" Advocacy Program of Fortune Life, Department of Education and MaryLindbert Int'l who manifested profound COMMITMENT to the DEVELOPMENT of the values of HARDWORK and DISCIPLINE of the YOUTH, exemplified HARDWORK, DISCIPLINE and DEDICATION to their WORK, EFFECTIVE EDUCATIONAL LEADERSHIP and EXCELLENCE in the TEACHING PROFESSION.

Nominees' background relative to the above criteria must be done in PowerPoint Presentation format. It should include:

- A composition (not more than 1,500 words) to show how the nominee's exemplified hardwork and discipline, served as role models to their students and has inspired them to follow a path to champion hardwork and discipline.
- A composition (not more than 1,000 words) written by one of the students/pupils of the nominee on the theme: "Hard Work and Discipline – How I have learned from My Teacher and Have Applied to My Daily Life"
- Pictures/Videos showing the nominee practicing, advocating or teaching hardwork and discipline to his students, family, peers and the community he belongs

Eligibility/General Qualifications:

1. Must be a Filipino citizen
2. A permanent employee of the Department of Education as a teacher, principal, supervisor or an educator in the formal and non-formal basic education Alternative Learning System of the department.
3. Actively teaching/working in the Philippines for the last 5 years
4. With valid PRC license.

5. With average teaching performance/work performance rating of "very satisfactory" in the last 3 years.
6. Have at least a Bachelor's degree.

There will be 10 finalists to be chosen from the pool of nominees. A panel of judges from MaryLindbert Int'l and the Department of Education will conduct an actual evaluation of the finalists. Visits in the schools and community of the finalists and interviews with the pupils/students of the finalists will be conducted to choose the 5 Gawad Parangal Ni Amb. Antonio Cabangon-Chua.
