The PHSA conducts screening of applicants annually to continuously search for artistically talented children who will be given special training in the following fields:

1. Ballet and folk dance;

, The applicant must be a Filipino citizen who can meet the following requirements:

- 1. Outstanding ability in dance (folk or ballet); music (instrument and voice), creative writing, theater and visual arts;
- Graduating Grade 6 pupil this school year (SY) 2014-2015;
- 3. Proficient in oral and written language (English and Filipino);
- 4. Good health condition;
- 5. Willing to study in a boarding school;
- Determined to pursue a college degree in fine arts or architecture, music, dance, theater, creative writing, journalism or any related courses upon graduation from PHSA; and
- 7. Not more than 14 years old.

The deadline for submission of accomplished application form is on or before August 31, 2014.

SCHOOL PHILOSOPHY

A government-run secondary school for artistically gilled and talented ren and adolescents, the Philippine High School for the Arts (PHSA) implements a special secondary education curriculum and support programs committed to the conservation and promotion of the Pilpino artistic and cultural fractions. Since 1977, PHSA states to develop the experies and potentials of its young artists-actolors, faculty, and staff as cultural workers dedicated to achieving the actoor's tissues characterized by an unumening pride in the Filipino people's artistic and cultural traditions. Aside from academic and artistic training, PHSA provides its students with apportunities to develop their social shifts feat will contribute to their development as adists for others. The experience of living away from home and integrating with mentors and poors in this residential high school, cultivates in the young artists an attitude of independence tempered by the spirit of cooperation. The site of the achool is a vitel factor in making the PHSA a most ideal learning inellitation. The mystical mountain of Maria Makiling is deemed to be a poughtul source of inspiration for artistic endeavors among young artists and their membes. Firm in its belief that artists play a major role in nation-building, the PHSA continuously isnovates activities and projects that directly address the socioeconomic, political and cultural realities in the country.

SEARCH OBJECTIVE

The Philippine High School for the Arts (PHSA) conducts screening of applicants yearly to identify and develop artistically gilled and talented children by implementing a special secondary education curriculum and support programs to provide the country with a continuing source of artists ince and leaders in the conservation and promotion of the Filipino artistic and cultural traditions.

SCHOLARSHIP PRIVILEGES

The successful applicant is swarded free builtion fee, board and lodging (with weekend home leave with the parents or with a designated legal quartian), classes with master teachers, a monthly stipend, plus the chance to represent the country and the school in international festivals, competitions and exchange programs. The grant is renewable every year for four consecutive school years upon salisfaction of academic and non-academic requirements.

CURRICULUM

The Basic Education subjects prescribed by the Department of Education are in the PHSA curriculum. These subjects are handled distinctively in support of the specialized studies for creative and artistic expressions in the following disciplines -

- Creative Widling (Fiction, Poetry, Playuriting, and Journalism in English and Filipino)
- Dance (Classical Ballet, Modern Dance, Philippine Folk Dance, Dance Composition and Staging)
- Music (Solo Voice/Solo Instrument, Theory, Composition, and Ensemble Classes (Chorus and Chamber)
- Theater Arts (Acting, Production Management, Technical Theater, History of the Theater, Theater Theory and Directing)
- Yisual Arts (Visual Perception, Sculpture, Art Appreciation, Studio Painting, Materials and Techniques, Figuration, Pottery, and Printmolano)

SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

As a state-supported special secondary school, PHSA accepts only a limited number of freehouse every year. Armusi intake averages forty to fifty students only to ensure a more individualized and differentiated academic and arts training programs possible.

To be eligible for scholarship, an applicant must ~

- be Filipino citizen with no pending application as immigrant to any foreign country;
- have an outstanding ability in an art discipline:
- be a graduating Grade VI pupil at the time of application;
- be able to take up the scholarship in the School Year for which it is granted;
- not be older than 14 years upon enrolment:
- be proficient in craft and written Filipino and English, be willing to study in a residential achook
- have no dubilisting illnesses or systemic and/or communicable diseases such as serum sickness, congenital heart disease, systemic tupus erythemotoeus, hepatilis A andlor B, untreated primary complex, chronic office media, mutaria, bronchial asthma, and/or seizures/involuntary tramors;
- and be determined to pursue a college degree in Dence, Creative Writing, Architecture, Fine Arts, Music, Theater Arts, Journalism, or any related courses upon graduation from PHSA.

SCHOLARSHIP REQLIREMENTS

The following documents must be received by the Search Committee for the preliminary evaluation of scholarship applications:

- fully accomplished PHSA Scholarship Application Form,
- photocopy of Birth Certificate issued by the NSO;
- photocopy of Grade V or Grade VI Report Card;
- one-page resume citing accomplishments in the art field of interest:
- ton (10 samples of works (e.g. short story, poem, essay) in Filipino and/or English, typewritten, double-speced on A4 white bond paper authenticated by the tracher-in-charge (for creative writing)
- ten (10) images of artivories (jpeg formel) in CD or DVD (for visual arts)-optional

Official records and other documents will not be returned to the applicant. Please be advised not to submit original copies when not required to.
