**2014 Metrobank MTAP-DepED Math Challenge
(Division Elimination Round)**



This Division**

1. Pursuant to DepED Memorandum No. 205, s. 2013, the Metrobank Foundation, Inc. (MBFI), Mathematics Teachers Association of the Philippines (MTAP), and the Department of Education (DepED) will conduct the 2014 Metrobank-MTAP-DepED Math Challenge from November 4, 2013 to March 01, 2014 at separate venues as stated in paragraph 7 hereof.
2. The overall objective of the competition is to contribute in improving the quality of Mathematics education in the Philippines.
3. **The Division MTAP Elimination Round is scheduled come January 16 for the Elementary and January 17 for the Secondary.**
4. All public and private schools that were able to submit the photocopy of the accomplished one-page registration form which indicates the school's official contestants and coaches per grade/year level until November 11, 2013 were the only qualified contestants of the said competition. Original copy of the said registration form will be presented to the registration-in-charge during the Elimination Round as this will serve as the permit of joining the competition. *No Permit, No Entry Policy* shall be implemented. Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools that submitted a copy of the registration forms are listed in *Enclosure No. 1*.
5. The **Division Elimination Round – Elementary** shall be conducted in four (4) groups or clusters. All of the six districts including private elementary schools are geographically clustered as follows:
 - Cluster 1: Malaybalay City Far East District
 - Cluster 2: Malaybalay City East and South Districts
 - Cluster 3: Malaybalay City Central & West Districts
 - Cluster 4: Malaybalay City North and All Private Elementary Schools

6. For the **Division Elimination Round – Secondary** it shall be conducted at **Bukidnon State University (BSU) Auditorium, Malaybalay City.**
7. The competition shall be held simultaneously, preferably on the stage, inside the gym or any function room that can accommodate the expected participants and audience for the competition. The following schedule shall be followed:
