ADDENDUM and CORRIGENDUM TO DIVISION MEMORANDUM NO. 11, S. 2014 (2014 Metrobank MTAP-DepED Math Challenge – Division Elimination Round)

- 1. Pursuant to the operating guidelines (MMC Documents Nos. 2 and 3 as contained in the enclosure of DepED Memorandum No. 205, s. 2013, entitled 2014 Metrobank-MTAP-DepED Math Challenge and Division Memorandum No. 11, s. 2014 entitled 2014 Metrobank MTAP-DepED Math Challenge Division Elimination Round, this office informs the field that the Division Education Program Supervisors (EPS) and the Division Program Coordinators are the Testing Center Coordinators and at the same time the Test Examiners as indicated in paragraph 3 hereof. They shall be responsible together with the Division MTAP Coordinator as the over-all incharge for settling all questions, including protests, which may arise in the course of the competition and in-charge of the preparation, implementation and documentation of the Elimination Rounds in the specific testing venues.
- 2. Each testing venue has to assign two proctors preferably from the non-teaching staff or if not available from the School Administrators duly recommended by the Public Schools District Supervisors of the clustered district responsible for the proper conduct of items no. 5 to 11 of the Contest Mechanics (MMC Document No. 3). A number of checkers will also be identified preferably all the registered coaches of each grade/year level per school but caution is given that they should not check the test papers of their own school students participants. A review of the answer keys by the coaches prior to the final checking of the test papers shall be done if needed to ensure of the technical correctness of the answers. Answer keys shall only be opened just before correction begins. Each correct answer merits one point.

3. The Testing Center Coordinators of the specific testing venues and the specified time allotment of the competition for each of the grade/year level are the following:

All public and private schools are required to accomplish a one-page registration form contained in Enclosure No. 3 duly certified by the principal/registrar, which indicates the school's official contestants and coaches/trainors per grade/year level. A photocopy of the accomplished form should be sent directly to the DepEd Division Mathematics Supervisor-in-charge, where the school is located, on or before November 4, 2013. The school must present the original copy to the registration-in-charge during the Elementary Elimination Round on December 5, 2013 or December 6, 2013 for High School. This serves as permit in joining the competition. No Permit, No Entry policy shall be implemented.

- 5. The concerned DepEd Division Mathematics Supervisors shall then accomplish the summary of participants contained in Enclosure No. 4 which indicates the testing centers and the total number of pupils/students per grade/year per testing center. The accomplished form must be validated by their respective Schools Division Superintendent (SDS) and be submitted to MTAP on or before **November 11, 2013** through email address: mmc_secretariat@yahoo.com or through fax nos. (02) 912-5249; (02) 709-0447.
- 6. Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the no-disruption-of-classes policy as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2009 entitled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith.



ABOUT THE COMPETITION

I. NATURE

The Metrobank-MTAP-DepEd Math Challenge is a Mathematics competition for elementary and secondary students in both public and private schools nationwide. It is implemented by the Metrobank Foundation, Inc. (MBFI), the Mathematics Teachers Association of the Philippines (MTAP) and the Department of Education (DepEd).

II. OBJECTIVES

The overall objective of the Metrobank-MTAP-DepEd Math Challenge is to contribute in improving the quality of mathematics education in the Philippines. Specifically, it aims to:

- A. Awaken greater interest in Mathematics among elementary and secondary students in both public and private schools all over the country;
- B. Encourage students to strive for excellence in Mathematics;
- C. Encourage mastery of basic mathematical skills;
- D. Discover mathematical talents among the students;
- E. Develop the values of hard work, perseverance, honesty, teamwork and sportsmanship; and
- F. Provide students with opportunities in leadership and cooperative undertaking.

III. COVERAGE

The coverage of the competition shall be the current DepEd Education Curriculum for Elementary and Secondary, per grade/year level.

WHO ARE QUALIFIED

A. <u>Eliminations</u>: All bonafide students enrolled in Grades I to VI and Grade 7 to 4th Year in any public and private school in 17 regions including those from SUCs, as certified by the principal or registrar of the school

Note: Contestants must be actually enrolled in the grade/year level they are competing. In **NO** instance shall mixed grade/year level participation in team competition be allowed. Only **three (3)** students per grade/year level shall represent each school, for both public and private.

B. <u>Division Finals:</u> The top six (min.) to 20 (max.) highest scoring schools in the elimination round per grade/year level, Grades I to VI and Grade VII to 4th Year may participate.

Note: The number of qualified division finalists depends on the total number of schools that will participate in the elimination round. Please refer to the Contest Mechanics (MMC Document No. 3) for details.

C. Regional Finals:

- Individual Competition: All top placers in each division during the elimination round, for both Grade VI and 4th Year provided they meet the hurdle rate of 25 points out of a perfect score of 50.
- Team Competition: All the 1st placers during the Division Finals, for both Grade VI and 4th Year provided they meet the hurdle rate of 30 points out of a perfect score of 60.
- D. National Finals (for both Individual and Team Category)
 - For both Elementary and Secondary Levels:
 - i. Top scorers for both Categories A & B in NCR
 - ii. Top scorer in each geographical area (Rest of Luzon, VIsayas, and Mindanao)
 - iii. Remaining five (5) top scorers across all regions
 - Individual and Team contestants should meet the hurdle rate of 45 points out of a perfect score of 60.

HOW TO JOIN

ALL public and private schools are required to accomplish a one-page registration form (MMC Form 1) duly certified by the principal/registrar, which indicates the school's official contestants and coaches/trainers per grade/year level. A photocopy of the accomplished form should be sent directly to the DepEd Division Math Supervisor In-charge where the school is located, on or before November 4, 2013. The school must present the original copy to the registration in-charge during the Elimination Round on December 5, 2013 (Elementary) or December 6, 2013 (High School). This serves as permit in joining the competition. "No permit, No Entry" policy shall be implemented.

The concerned DepEd Division Math Supervisors shall then accomplish the summary of participants (MMC Form 2) which indicates the testing centers and the total number of students per grade/year per testing center. The accomplished form must be validated by the DepEd Division Superintendent and be submitted to MTAP on or before November 11, 2013 through email at mmc_secretariat@yahoo.com or through fax no. (02) 912-5249 and/or (02) 709-0447.






STAGES OF THE COMPETITION

B. TEAM COMPETITION




PRIZES AND REWARDS

- I. FOR STUDENTS
- A. Elimination Stage (Grades I to VI; Grade 7 to 4th Year)

The following top-ranking students shall be given certificates of merit:

1st Honors: for those who get 90% correct answers



B. Division Finals (Grades I to VI; Grade VII to 4th Year)

- Medals and certificates for each member of the top 3 winning teams per grade/year level
- Certificates of recognition for the schools of the top 3 winning teams, per grade/year level
- Certificates of appreciation for all coaches/trainors
- Certificates of merit for non-winning contestants

C. Regional Finals (Grade VI and 4th Year)

- Medals and cash prizes for the top 3 individual winners and members of the top 3 winning teams per level
- Certificates of recognition for the top 3 individual winners and members of the top 3 winning teams per grade/year level
- Trophies for the schools of the top 3 winning teams per level
- Certificates of recognition for all coaches/trainors
- Certificates of merit for non-winning Regional Finalists

D. National Finals (Grade VI and 4th Year)

- Medals and cash prizes for the top 3 individual winners and the members of the top 3 winning teams per level
- Trophies for the schools of the top 3 winning teams per level
- Certificates of recognition for all coaches/trainors
- Certificates of recognition for National Finalists

II. FOR COACHES

Coaches in the Regional and National Finals will receive cash allowance. However, if the coach handles both individual and team contestants from the same school, he/she will receive cash allowance only once.

COMPETITION IMPLEMENTORS

A National Steering Committee composed of officers / representatives from MBFI, MTAP and DepEd, shall oversee the implementation and formulate the guidelines, policies and mechanics of the competition.

The <u>MBFI</u> shall serve as major sponsor and thus, be involved in all aspects and phases of the competition including supervision of the <u>National Finals and Awarding Ceremonies</u>.

The <u>MTAP</u> shall oversee the conduct of the Regional Finals in coordination with DepEd and the National Finals in coordination with MBFI. MTAP will also be responsible for settling all questions, including protests, which may arise in the course of the competition at the <u>Regional Level</u>.

The <u>DepEd</u> shall supervise the competition from the Elimination Rounds to the Regional Finals and shoulder expenses incidental thereto from sources to be determined by participating parties. DepEd will also be responsible for settling all questions, including protests, which may arise in the course of the competition from the <u>Elimination to the Division Level</u>.

OPERATING GUIDELINE

MMC Document No. 2

I. SCHOOL LEVEL:

- 1. A school is recommended to have a competition using a written exam by grade/year level prepared by the school.
- 2. The top three students per grade/year level who will obtain the highest scores will represent the school in the Elimination Round.

Note: The elimination round is open to ALL interested schools, both private and public. It is suggested that school districts should not conduct their own elimination to choose contestants for the whole district. This is to give each school equal chances of joining.

3. There shall be a maximum of (18) pupils for Elementary and/or (12) students for Secondary in every participating school, broken down as follows.

- 4. All participating <u>public</u> and <u>private</u> schools are required to accomplish a one-page <u>Registration Form</u> (<u>MMC Form 1</u>), a photocopy of which should be sent directly to the <u>DepEd Division Math Supervisor</u> in-charge on or before <u>November 4, 2013</u>.
- 5. The school must present the original copy to the registration in-charge during the Elimination Round on December 5, 2013 (Elementary) or December 6, 2013 (High School). This serves as permit in joining the competition. "No permit, No Entry" policy shall be implemented.
- 6. The concerned DepEd Division Math Supervisors shall then collate all MMC Form 1 and accomplish the summary of participants (MMC Form 2) which indicates the testing centers and the total number of students per grade/year per testing center. The accomplished form must be validated by the DepEd Division Superintendent and be submitted to MTAP on or before November 11, 2013 through email at mmc_secretariat@yahoo.com.ph or through fax at tel. no. (02) 912-5249 and/or (02) 709-0447. Failure to submit may cause delay in sending the test questionnaires and conduct of the elimination round, which is scheduled on December 5-6, 2013.

II. ELIMINATION ROUNDS

- 7. The DepEd Division Math Supervisor shall be in-charge of the preparation, implementation and documentation of the Elimination Rounds competition. He/she will also be responsible for settling all questions, including protests, which may arise in the course of the competition, or a panel of advisers may be formed by the Schools Division Superintendent.
- 8. The test materials shall be prepared by MTAP and transmitted through the nearest Metrobank branch in the Division. Please see attached list of Metrobank branches vis-à-vis the DepEd Division.

- 9. In case there is no Metrobank branch in the area, the test materials shall be delivered to the DepEd Division Office/s through the Schools Division Superintendent.
- 10. The concerned Branch Manager or Schools Division Superintendent shall turnover the questionnaires personally to the Division Math Supervisor on <u>December 4, 2013</u> for Elementary and <u>December 5, 2013</u> for High School.
- 11. The Division Math Supervisor shall then turnover the questionnaires to the Testing Center Coordinators on the same date. A certification on top of the package which contains the questionnaires will be signed by the Metrobank Branch Manager, Schools Division Superintendent, the Division Math Supervisor and the Testing Center Coordinator to document the said turnover of test questionnaires.
- 12. A Division may have one or more testing centers depending on the distance between the schools, the size of the Division and the number of participating schools. It will be feasible to have one center per District for the elementary; for the secondary, a cluster of towns may have one center. A cluster of City Divisions with very few secondary schools may also have just one center.
- **Example:** Suppose Division A has 20 participating schools. Then, there will be 20 x 3 or 60 Grade I pupils to take the test, 60 for Grade II, up to Grade VI or a total of 360 pupils who will take the test in the Center. If those 20 schools are very far from each other, the Division may have more than one center for them.
- 13. The test materials will be opened publicly by the Testing Center Coordinator just before the start of the competition at 8:00 a.m. A short opening program may be conducted where the materials will be officially opened. A certification will be signed by the Testing Center Coordinator and selected proctors to document the proceedings.
- 14. In case the number of questionnaires sent is not enough, photocopying is <u>NOT ALLOWED</u>. <u>Only preregistered participants shall be allowed to take the test</u>. Thus participating schools must ensure that they submitted a photocopy of their MMC Form 1 to their local DepEd Divisions.
- 15. The Elimination Round should be held simultaneously in all regions nationwide on November 28-29, 2013 at 8:30 a.m. As agreed upon by the MMC National Steering Committee, conduct of the contest other than this schedule is not allowed.
- 16. The test papers will be corrected using the key provided. Please refer to the Guidelines in Checking the Test Papers.
- 17. <u>The winners of the elimination round should be announced on the date of the competition</u>, then followed by a DepEd Memo to formalize the announcement.
- 18. In case the results will not be released because of a valid reason (i.e. too many schools joined and the assigned correctors will not be able to finish checking the test papers on time), the Division Math Supervisor should announce the results on or before <u>December 13, 2013.</u>
- 19. The school scores of the whole Division per grade/year shall be ranked from highest to lowest.

 Please refer to the MMC Document No. 3 (Contest Mechanics) Item no.13 for the guide in computing the total scores for participating schools.

20. The top 6 to 20 highest scoring schools qualify to participate in the **Division Team Finals** competition. The number of teams qualified to join the Division Finals is dependent on the number of participating schools in the elimination rounds. Please refer to matrix below:

Note: 20 is the maximum number of teams because experience indicates that it is the most manageable number for an oral team competition.

- 21. The DepEd Math Supervisor shall submit to MTAP the **MMC Form No. 3** (summary of the number of team which are qualified to join the Division Finals) through email at mmc_secretariat@yahoo.com or through fax at tel. no. (02) 912.5249.
- 22. Certificates of Merit shall be awarded to students from Grades I to VI and Grade 7 to 4th Years who qualify under the following conditions, based on their performance in the Elimination Rounds:

23. The top Grade 6 and 4th Year individuals of each Division in the elimination rounds automatically qualifies to the Regional Finals provided he/she meets the hurdle rate of 25 out of a perfect score of 50 or 50% out of the perfect score.

III. DIVISION FINALS

- 24. The <u>DepEd Division Math Supervisor</u> shall be in-charge of the preparation, implementation and documentation of the Division Finals competition including preparation of the program and designation of judges, proctors and hosts/quizmasters. <u>He/she will also be responsible for settling all questions, including protests, which may arise in the course of the competition, or a panel of advisers may be formed by the Division Schools Superintendent.</u>
- 25. The test materials shall be prepared by MTAP and transmitted through the same Metrobank branch in the Division/area coordinated during the elimination rounds.

26. In case there is no Metrobank branch in the area, the test materials shall be delivered to the Division Office/s through the Schools Division Superintendent

- 27. The concerned Branch Manager or Schools Division Superintendent shall turn-over the questionnaires personally to the DepEd Division Math Supervisor on the day of the Division Finals, January 16, 2014 (Elementary) and January 17, 2014 (High School).
- 28. An Opening Program for the Division Finals should be made at <u>8:00 am</u> where the package of test questionnaires shall be <u>opened publicly</u> and to be witnessed by the Branch Manager or Schools Division Superintendent.
- 29. The Team Orals should be conducted in two different venues (Grades 1-3 in one venue and Grade 4-6 in another venue). The competition should be held simultaneously, preferably on the stage, inside the gym or any function room that can accommodate audience for the competition.
- 30. The following schedule of competition shall be followed:

- 31. The results of the Division Finals should be announced immediately after the competition and a DepEd memo should be issued to formalize the announcement. A copy of the memo should be furnished to the DepEd Regional Math Supervisor for reference in preparation for the Regional Finals.
- 32. **Medals and certificates** will be awarded to the members of the <u>top 3 winning teams</u> per grade/year level regardless of their scores.
- 33. First place winners in the Grade VI and 4th Year High School in the Division Finals are qualified to compete in the *Regional Finals* provided they meet the hurdle rate of **30 points out of a perfect score of 60**.
- 34. Certificates of Recognition will be awarded to the schools of the top 3 winning teams. Certificates of appreciation will be given to all coaches and staff members of the competition. All non-winning contestants will be given certificates of merit.
- 35. The Division Math Supervisor shall submit completion report in conducting the elimination and Division Finals on or before February 14, 2014. Only an electronic copy of the report should be submitted through email at mmc secretariat@yahoo.com, with the following content:

IV. REGIONAL FINALS

- 36. The <u>DepEd Regional Math Supervisor</u> shall be in-charge of the preparation, implementation and documentation of the Regional Finals, including preparation of program, designation of judges, proctors, correctors for the individual competition and hosts/quizmasters. He/She must also endeavor to provide whatever assistance needed by the MTAP representative.
- 37. An <u>MTAP representative</u> will assist in facilitating this stage of the contest, both in the individual and team competition. <u>He/she will also be responsible for settling all questions, including protests, which may arise in the course of the competition</u>.
- 38. The MTAP representative shall bring the questionnaires and awarding materials on the date of the contest.

A. INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION: (Grade VI and 4th Year only)

- 39. The competition shall be conducted in a close room. For this competition, the contestants must use their code numbers given to them at the registration.
- 40. There may be more than one corrector for the papers, but only one may correct either Part II or III for the sake of consistency in the giving of partial credit. Each paper must be counter-checked by a corrector of another part of the paper.
- 41. The top three scorers will be awarded with certificates, medals and cash prizes regardless of their scores.
- 42. Certificates of merit will be given to all non-winning Regional Finalists and certificates of recognition for all trainors/coaches.

B. TEAM COMPETITION: (Grade VI and 4th Year only)

- 43. The conduct of the competition shall be the same with the Division Team Oral Finals.
- 44. The following schedule shall be followed:

45. The top 3 teams will be declared winners and will be awarded with certificates, medals and cash prizes regardless of their scores. Trophies will be awarded to the schools of the winning team;

- regardless of their scores. Certificates of recognition will be given to all coaches and staff members. All non-winning Regional Finalists will be given certificates of merit.
- 46. Coaches of both individual and team contestants shall be given cash allowance by the Metrobank Branch representative concerned. However, in case the individual and team Regional Finalists come from the same school, only the coach of the team shall be given cash allowance. This should be announced by the Host/Quizmaster during the OPENING PROGRAM.
- 47. The Metrobank Foundation will provide the cash prizes, medals and trophies while MTAP, shall provide certificates.

V. NATIONAL FINALS

A. SELECTION OF NATIONAL FINALISTS: (Grade VI and 4th Year only)

- 48. Scores of all regional first place winners in each geographical area, i.e., NCR, Rest of Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao, for both individual and team competition, shall be ranked from highest to lowest.
- 49. Slots Allocation of National Finalists:

For both Elementary and Secondary Levels

- ▶Top scorers for both Categories A & B in NCR
- ➤ Top scorers in each geographical are (Rest of Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao)
- ➤ Remaining five (5) top scorers across all regions.
- 50. Top rankers must also meet the "hurdle rate" established by the National Steering Committee, which is 45 points out of a perfect score of 60 points.
- 51. In case of tie, the Metrobank Branch concerned will administer the tie-breaking test at a designated venue, in coordination with the DepED Regional Office.
- 52. National Finalists shall be notified formally by Metrobank Foundation as soon as the consolidation of results is completed by MTAP and MBFI.

B. INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION: (Grade VI and 4th Year)

- 53. The individual contestants will undergo both written and oral competitions. The individual written competition will be administered a day before the oral competition.
- 54. The final score of each individual contestant will be 60% of written score + 40% of the oral score. This will be announced after the oral competition.
- 55. The contestants will be ranked according to the combined scores and the top three will be declared winners.

C. TEAM COMPETITION: (Grade VI and 4th Year)

56. The team contestants will undergo an oral competition only. Note: The complete mechanics of both the individual and team competitions at the national level shall be explained prior to the start of
