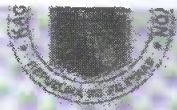

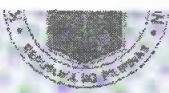
SUBJECT : Nominees to the Public Management and Development Program
(Middle Managers Class Batches 5 and 6)

DATE : January 14, 2014

1. The Development Academy of the Philippines (DAP) is announcing the opening of nominations for Public Management Development Program for Middle Managers Class (Batches 5 and 6) which is expected to open in March and July 2014, respectively.

2. The Middle Managers Class (MMC) is designed for high performing, high potential incumbents of SG-18 to SG-24 positions. MMC is composed of two phases: Residential Training Phase and Re-entry Project Implementation. The Residential Training will run for about 6 months in DAP Tagaytay, excluding weekends and with 2-week working breaks, while the Re-entry Projects are expected to be implemented for 3-months immediately after the Residential training. The 2-week working break is one of the elements of the restructured MMC design. It is expected to provide participants with training intervals to help them keep abreast of their concerns in the office, while giving them enough time to absorb the lessons learned during the intensive, fast-paced learning modules.

3. The criteria and qualifications for Middle Managers Class are the following:
- Occupying a permanent non-teaching position involved in public management and policy making
 - High performing and high potential (HPHP) employees with SG 18-24 positions
 - 55 years old and below at the time of the PMDP conduct
 - Bachelor's Degree holder
 - Nominated by the head of agency
 - VS or Outstanding performance rating for the past two years
 - No pending administrative and/or criminal case
 - Did not go on habitual leave (max of 2 months/year)
 - Willing to sign a service contract up to three years after completing the program
 - Possesses managerial and leadership potential
 - With good character and commitment to public service

 - m. Must be in good health (no debilitating chronic illnesses or serious health condition)
 - n. Must have excellent communication skills (both oral and written)
4. Each region is to send four (4) nominees noting the criteria and qualifications. Nominees endorsed by the Department will undergo the preliminary screening, examination and interview to be conducted by DAP. Successful applicants will receive full government scholarships. MMC scholars who are able to satisfy the academic requirements of the program, will be conferred a Master's degree in Development Management.
