- 1- As a component of the Division School Health and Nutrition Program year-end activity, this Office enjoins all concern to observe DM no 500, s. 1997 re: ENSURING PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF PTB (PULMONARY TUBERCULOSIS) AND OTHER AILMENTS AMONG TEACHERS which is self-explanatory.
- 2- It is reiterated that all teaching and non-teaching personnel shall undergo Chest X-ray and urinalysis in any accredited private/public hospital as part of the advocacy campaign to maintain health and work efficiency among personnel. Original copies of examination results shall be submitted by Section (Division Office), schools (Secondary), and Districts for intervention and consolidation, Attn: School Health and Nutrition Section not later than April 11,2014.



ENSURING THE PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF PTB AND OTHER DISEASES AMONG TEACHERS

To Undersecretaries

The recent field reports on school health have revealed that 2.7% of public school teachers were found to be suffering from pulmonary tuberculosis diseases were likewise prevalent among them despite efforts of health the purchase of supplies and for travel expenses for greater mobility of personnel health care delivery.

The health status of the teachers has to be given utmost attention; effectively perform their roles and responsibilities for education.

To ensure the prevention and control of PTB and other diseases among teachers, regional directors, schools division superintendents and other concerned officials are enjoined to:

a implement the annual health examination (including chest x-ray and urinalysis) of teachers and newly appointed personnel;

- b. allow teachers who are found positive for PTB (moderate and far-advanced cases) to undergo treatment and to go on sick leave with pay for not more than fifteen (15) working days;
- c integrate in their annual budget the payment of health examination of regional and division office personnel; and
- d Instruct the school health and nutrition personnel to conduct a continuing advocacy campaign on the prevention and control of the monitoring of compliance of regular treatment.
- Medicines for the treatment of PTB cases shall be provided by the School Health and Nutrition Center (SHNC). The consolidated reports on the program shall be integrated in the quarterly reports for submission to the SHNC
