

2014 MTAP-DEPED SATURDAY MATHEMATICS PROGRAM

- 1. Pursuant to DepEd Advisory No. 275, s. 2014, the Mathematics Teachers Association of the Philippines (MTAP), announces the conduct of the 2014 MTAP-DepEd Saturday Mathematics Program.
- There are two programs, one is intended for regular pupils/students. This will be conducted on six Saturdays, 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon from August 9 to September 13, 2014. The other one is for mathematically talented pupils/students. This will be conducted on seven Saturdays, 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon from October 11 to November 29, 2014, except November 1, 2014.
- 3. A nominal fee of Two Hundred Pesos for the six sessions and seven hundred pesos for the seven sessions, which must be paid at the center where the pupil/student will participate on or before August 9 and October 11, 2013 respectively.
- 4. Each District is encouraged to put up their District MTAP Saturday Program. Big, Central and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools are enjoined to have their Center with at least 15 pupils per class. To avail of MTAP materials in the Division, each center should submit the List of MTAP pupils/students to the Division Office on or before August 5, 2014, Attention: Imelda S. Bentillo EPS in Mathematics.
- 5. Division MTAP Officers, District Math Coordinator and MTAP Center Coordinators is scheduled to meet on August 7, 2014 at 1:30 in the afternoon at the Division Conference Room for organization and orientation.
- 6. Travelling and other expenses is chargeable against Schools/District MTAP Funds.
- 7. Enclosed is the pro-forma of parent's permit allowing their child to attend Saturday Classes.
- 8. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.

ANNOUNCEMENT

The 2014 MTAP DepEd Saturday Program in Mathematics will be conducted on six (6) Saturdays from August 9 to September 13, 2014 for the regular and seven (7) Saturdays for the excel Program from October 11 to November 29, 2014. The sessions will be for the 25th to the 85th percentile of the pupils/students at each grade/year level, Grade I to 4th year. The classes will be from 8:00 to 12:00 noon. Pupils/Students are required to attend in uniform and with their school ID. In case the uniform is in the wash, pupils/students may attend in their P.E. uniform.

The fee of P200.00 for the Regular program for 6 sessions and P250.00 for the excel program for 7 sessions. Pupils/Students may paid to the Center where they choose to attend Saturday classes.

The program aims at providing pupils/students the opportunity to do Mathematics with some explorations without the threat of test, giving an intensive review of the work of the previous year and the first few weeks of this year.

2014 MTAP-DEPED SATURDAY MATHEMATICS PROGRAMS

The Mathematics Teachers Association of the Philippines (MTAP) will be offering the 2014 MTAP-DepEd Saturday Mathematics Programs for regular pupils/students and for talented pupils/students.

The first program is intended for regular pupils/students. This will be conducted on six Saturdays, 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon from August 9 to September 13, 2014. The sessions will be for pupils/students who belong from the 25th to the 85th percentile at each grade/year level from Grade 1 to Fourth Year. A written permit from the parents is necessary.

The first program aims to:

- 1. provide the pupils and students the opportunity to explore Mathematics without the threat of tests;
- 2. review the materials covered last school year that enabled them to do well in Mathematics in the present school year; and
- 3. prepare the Grade 6 pupils and Fourth Year students for entrance examinations for First Year high school and college levels.

The second program is for mathematically talented pupils/students. This will be conducted on seven Saturdays, 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon from October 11 to November 29, 2014, except November 1, 2014. The sessions will be for pupils/students who belong to the top 15th percentile. The school principal shall endorse the pupils/students who wish to participate, along with a written permit from their parents/guardians.

The second program aims to:

- 1. prepare the Grade 6 pupils and Fourth Year students for entrance examinations for First Year high school and college levels; and
- 2. prepare them for the Metrobank-MTAP-DepEd Math Challenge Competition.
