- 8. The NCCA shall provide scholarship provisions consisting of free registration, conference kits and materials, and certificates of participation for the first 120 qualified participants for the island-cluster conference nominated and endorsed by schools division superintendents, district supervisors, or school heads of public elementary and secondary schools. Priority shall be given to those who have attended the Graduate Diploma in Cultural Education Program offered by PCEP.

- 9. Transportation, meals and accommodation and other expenses not covered by the scholarship provisions shall be charged to local funds and should be arranged by the participants themselves. These expenses shall be subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 10. Interested participants who fail to qualify for the scholarship shall be charged the full registration fee of One Thousand Pesos (P 1,000.00) to cover registration fee, conference kits and materials. They shall also be responsible for all other participation-related costs which may be charged to local funds.
