1. Pursuant to DepED Order No. 62, s. 2011 on Adopting the Indigenous Peoples' Education Policy Framework which focuses on the IPs Rights, which is an integral part of the K-12 Program that gives primary importance to the principles of participation, inclusion and empowerment, the Division of Malaybalay City will conduct an **Division Orientation of Community Representatives and Civil Society Groups on the National IPed Policy Framework with the following schedule** on October 21, 2014 & November 12, 2014
