



- 1. Pursuant to the herein Fax Message for Transmission and Regional Advisory dated December 3, 2014, this Office hereby disseminates the Text Messages from the Central Office for information, guidance and strict compliance.
- 2. Relative thereto, this Office reiterates the text messages below:
  - 1) "Hi RD's and SDS's Typhoon Hagupit (Ruby) will be entering the Philippine Area of Responsibility on Thursday. Please be advised that the DRRM Central Office headed by ASEC Rey Laguda is in direct contact with your DRRM Focal Persons. All must be prepared in this typhoon. Make sure that all precautionary measures are exhausted. Coordinate with DRRM Central Office for Updates."
  - 2) "Please let us know if there are any SDS who are and will be on leave from Thursday to Sunday especially to the Region who will be affected by the update Please send raphael.magno@deped.gov.ph ASAP. Thank you Po."
  - 3) "RD's in anticipation of TS Ruby (Hagupit) please make sure that you and your respective SDS's personally attend all Local DRRM Council Meetings together with your DRRM Focal Persons. This is very crucial for the next few days as we anticipate the path. Please acknowledge receipt. CC Raf Magno and Mariel Bayangos, Br. Armin, USec Lino - Asec Rey."
  - 4) "Expectation is landfall on Saturday afternoon in Samar/E-Visayas, but as early as Friday we may experience rains already along Eastern SeaBoard,

600 diameter of the typhoon rain band. Tomorrow Thursday we will have a more accurate forecast from PAG-ASA. Yolanda path is highly probable expected winds is 160 kph with gustiness of 190 kph possible 3-4 meters of storm surge in East Samar. Other scenarios is it veers northwards."

5) "Even if Scenario 2 happen where it veers northwards we will still expect heavy rains for eastern seaboard, Central Mindanao, Central Visayas and Central Luzon due to the wide diameter of the rain band. Please take necessary precautions. Anticipate travel to be affected from Friday to Monday."

6) "By tomorrow, Thursday, all schools expected to be in path of Typhoon (refer to media releases) should be securing books, records and equipment from potential flooding or wind and rain damage. Trees should be pruned as needed. Secure loose items and materials in schools and offices. Coordinate with Baragay Officials. Divisions should take active role in preparation of our schools and our personnel for their own families."

7) "Please observe developments and advisories from PAG-ASA up to tomorrow morning Thursday, then RD's or your SDS's depending on potential impact, may strongly urge your LGU's to suspend classes for Friday as part of the pre-emptive measures and should there be evacuation measures as well. This will depend on how your divisions and region will be affected by Ruby."

3. Moreover, additional text message is also reiterated in the Regional Advisory dated December 3, 2014:

8) "Please advise contractors doing ongoing construction to also secure their materials and equipment and ensure that we minimize damage and losses PD".

- 1. "HI RD's & SDS's TYPHOON HAGUPIT (RUBY) WILL BE ENTERING THE PHILIPPINE AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY ON THURSDAY. PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT THE DRRM CENTRAL OFFICE HEADED BY ASEC REY LAGUDA IS IN DIRECT CONTACT WITH YOUR DRRM FOCAL PERSONS. ALL MUST BE PREPARED IN THIS TYPHOON. MAKE SURE THAT ALL PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES ARE EXHAUSTED. COORDINATE WITH DRRM CENTRAL OFFICE FOR UPDATES."
- 2. "PLEASE LET US KNOW IF THERE ARE ANY SDS WHO ARE AND WILL BE ON LEAVE FROM THRUSDAY TO SUNDAY ESPECIALLY TO THE REGION WHO WILL BE AFFECTED BY THE TYPHOON. PLEASE SEND UPDATE TO SDS ON LEAVE TO raphael, magno@deped.gov.ph ASAP. THANK YOU PO."
- 3. "RD's IN ANTICIPATION OF TS RUBY (HAGUPIT) PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT YOU AND YOUR RESPECTIVE SDS's PERSONALLY ATTEND ALL LOCAL DRRM COUNCIL MEETINGS TOGETHER WITH YOUR DRRM FOCAL PERSONS. THIS IS VERY CRUCIAL FOR THE NEXT FEW DAYS AS WE ANTICIPATE THE PATH. PLEASE ACKNOWLEDGE RECEIPT. CC RAF MAGNO AND MARIEL BAYANGOS, BR ARMIN, USEC LINO ASEC REY."

- 4. "EXPECTATION IS LANDFALL ON SATURDAY AFTERNOON IN SAMAR/E-VISAYAS, BUT AS EARLY AS FRIDAY WE MAY EXPERIENCE RAINS ALREADY ALONG EASTERN SEABOARD. 600 DIAMETER OF THE TYPHOON RAIN BAND. TOMORROW. THURSDAY WE WILL HAVE A MORE ACCURATE FORECAST FROM PAG-ASA. YOLANDA PATH IS HIGHLY PROBABLE EXPECTED WINDS IS 160 KPH WITH GUSTINESS OF 190 KPH POSSIBLE 3-4 METERS OF STORM SURGE IN EAST SAMAR. OTHER SCENARIOS IS IT VEERS NORTHWARDS."
- 5. "EVEN IF SCENARIO 2 HAPPEN WHERE IT VEERS NORTHWARDS WE WILL STILL EXPECT HEAVY RAINS FOR EASTERN SEABOARD, CENTRAL MINDANAO, CENTRAL VISAYAS AND CENTRAL LUZON DUE TO THE WIDE DIAMETER OF THE RAIN BAND. PLEASE TAKE NECESSARY PRECAUTIONS. ANTICIPATE TRAVEL TO BE AFFECTED FROM FRIDAY TO MONDAY."
- 6. "BY TOMORROW, THURSDAY, ALL SCHOOLS EXPECTED TO BE IN IN PATH OF TYPHOON (REFER TO MEDIA RELEASES) SHOULD BE SECURING BOOKS, RECORDS AND EQUIPMENT FROM POTENTIAL FLOODING OR WIND AND RAIN DAMAGE. TREES SHOULD BE PRUNED AS NEEDED. SECURE LOOSE ITEMS AND MATERIALS IN SCHOOLS AND OFFICES. COORDINATE WITH BARANGAY OFFICIALS. DIVISIONS SHOULD TAKE ACTIVE ROLE IN PREPARATION OF OUR SCHOOLS AND OUR PERSONNEL FOR THEIR OWN FAMILIES"
- 6. "PLEASE OBSERVE DEVELOPMENTS AND ADVISORIES FROM PAGASA UP TO TOMORROW MORNING THURSDAY, THEN RD'S OR YOUR SDS'S DEPENDING ON POTENTIAL IMPACT, MAY STRONGLY URGE YOUR LGU'S TO SUSPEND CLASSES FOR FRIDAY AS PART OF THE PRE-EMPTIVE MEASURES AND SHOULD THERE BE EVACUATION MEASURES AS WELL. THIS WILL DEPEND ON HOW YOUR DIVISIONS AND REGION WILL BE AFFECTED BY RUBY"
