4. Must have attended a patrol pre-camp training.

5. Must have 2 chaperons for every 6-8 Junior Girl Scouts

Note: The Adult chaperons for Senior/Cadet Girl Scouts can only assist their girls during settling down. They will attend the Leader's Gathering in a separate venue intended for them. Only Senior/Cadet Troop Leaders who were able to recruit at least 3 campers can attend the Leader's Gathering.

Departure : April 12, 2014 - Last Meal (Packed Lunch)


