EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 32
Series of 2014

AN ORDER SUSPENDING ALL CLASSES IN PRE-SCHOOL, ELEMENTARY AND HIGH SCHOOL LEVELS BOTH IN PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS IN THE CITY OF MALAYBALAY EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 5, 2014 AS A PRECAUTIONARY MEASURE FOR THE OCCURRENCE OF TYPHOON "RUBY".

Whereas, the Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA) had declared that the Typhoon "Ruby" (with international name "Hagupit) had already entered the Philippine Area Responsibility on December 4, 2014;

Whereas, the PAGASA had declared that the Province of Bukidnon will be among those areas to be affected by the said weather disturbance which will bring strong winds and rains as forecasted by the state weather agency;

Whereas, under Executive Order No. 66, series of 2012, local government chief executives, in their capacities as head of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils, are authorized to cancel or suspend classes in their jurisdiction even in the absence of storm signals, when, upon the recommendation of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council there is a need to suspend or cancel classes as a preventive or precautionary measure:

Whereas, in the emergency meeting of the Malaybalay City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council on December 4, 2014 at Roberto's Place, Malaybalay City, the members of the Council had unanimously recommended the cancellation/ suspension of classes of pre-school, elementary and high school levels in public and private schools in the City of Malaybalay effective December 5, 2014, as a precautionary and preemptive measure for the occurrence of Typhoon "Ruby";

NOW, THEREFORE, I, IGNACIO W. ZUBIRI, by the powers vested in me by law as City Mayor of Malaybalay, hereby order the cancellation and suspension of the classes of pre-school, elementary and high school levels of public and private schools in the City of Malaybalay effective December 5, 2014.

This Order shall remain effective until lifted.
