The target participants are the school heads, administrators, prescl elementary and secondary teachers from both public and private schools, instruc professors and education students in college of education and international deleg from other countries.



Day 1- Dr. Max Waish Curriculum Development for K to 12: Some Principles and Practices April 6, 2015 - 10:00 a.m. -12:00 noon, 1:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m.

The K-12 curriculum being introduced in the Philippines presents particular new challenges to teachers a learners in understanding exactly what is meant by "curriculum". Conscious decisions need to be made about what is to be included in the overt (written) curriculum and what is to be excluded. When certain subjects topics are excluded from the curriculum, students receive the message that this content is not import enough to study. How do we decide what is to be included and excluded, and can this change over time? These 2 seminar sessions will address different ways of understanding curriculum; introduce the important of school-based curriculum development and planning; show how to translate a curriculum into a syllab and then into a unit or lesson plan; execute the plan and then evaluate it. Participants will understand a importance of developing a curriculum relevant for different ways of learning, and ensuring that there is seamless integration of learning between various year groups and within subjects across year group. Activities will be provided to allow participants to develop their own understanding of curriculum as affects their personal teaching style and their particular groups of learners.

DR. MAX WALSH

Max is an Australian national but he has now lived continuously for 18 years in the Philippines and has adopted the Philippinese.

Before coming to the Philippines Dr Walsh was a Science & Math classroom teacher in the K-12 public school system in Austhon a Scnior Master of Science before being appointed as a Science Advisor to mentor teachers in Science at Early C Elementary and Secondary level. He then became a teacher educator in the University of Tasmania in Hobart, Tasmania, Ausbecame an Associate Dean during the next 17 years working in teacher education.

For the past 18 years whilst living in Manila he has worked on many Australian Government, World Bank and Asian Developmeducation development projects both in the Philippines as well as on various short-term consultancies in Afghanistan, Ba Cambodia, Georgia, Japan, Laos, Libya, Malaysia, Mongolia, Pakistan, Papua New Guinea, Singapore, Thailand, USA and Vietn

This recent wide-ranging international experience has given him a good appreciation of the standards and content as well as the d approaches to teaching and learning in Teacher Education in a range of SE Asian countries and beyond. His interest in teaching a learning means that he is very well-qualified to talk to us today on K-12 Teaching & Learning here in the Philippines.

DR. CARLO MAGNO

Dr. Carlo Magno is presently the Vice President for research and testing at the Asian Psychological Services and Assessment: He previously the director of the Lasallian Institute for Development and Educational Research in De La Salle University, Manila specialized area is on measurement, evaluation, and the analysis of test data particularly that of Item Response Theory. He trained in Structural Equations Modeling in Freie Universitat in Berlin, Germany. He has constructed several standardized meas scales, and tests for various purposes in the educational context. He received numerous awards in line with his research work surthe Outstanding Scientific Paper in Social Science in 2008 by the National Academy of Science and Technology, Honorary Regi Adviser of Time Taylor International, SEAMEO INNOTECH Research Fellow, and the 2011 Outstanding Young Scientist in Republic of the Philippines. He is one of the 200 renowned Global Scientist given recognition by the Global Science Academy published over 88 publications in scientific, refereed, and abstracted journals. In education, he received recognition for excellent teaching such as Students' Choice Award by the College of Education in DLSU, 2011 Lasallian Excellence Award Students Sc for Outstanding Teacher, Best Junior faculty in Psychology. He was commissioned by the DepEd in 2011 in writing the report policy recommendations for the K to 12 including the definitions of KPUP.

Dr. Magno has conducted several seminars, workshops, and fectures on educational development in teaching, learning,
