



### What is NOPTI?

NOPTI is the acronym of the National Organization of Professional Teachers, Inc. which is a non-profit, non-political and non-stock Corporation organized on October 24, 1998 and registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission on March 23, 1999 with Certificate of Registration No. 199904237.

### What is the legal basis of NOPTI?

Article III, Section 22 of Republic Act No. 7836, otherwise known as the Philippine Teachers Professionalization Act of 1994, provides that the teaching profession shall be integrated into national organization which shall be recognized by the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) and the Board of Professional Teachers (BPT). On March 25, 1999, the PRC and BPT recognized NOPTI as "the one and only" accredited professional teachers organization in the country."

### Is membership to NOPTI limited only to teachers in the Philippines?

No. NOPTI enjoins professional teachers working abroad, with valid PRC license to become members of NOPTI. In fact, NOPTI has now a big chapter in Hongkong which helps teachers avail of the "Balik-Turo" program of the Department of Education and extends other forms of support and assistance to its members.

### What makes NOTPI different from other teacher organizations?

Membership to NOPTI is open to both public and private school teachers with valid PRC license. NOPTI is not only concerned with teachers' material benefits but also with their continuing professional development.

### Is membership to NOPTI a bar to membership in other teacher organizations?

No. NOPTI respects and upholds freedom to organize or join organizations as provided for in the Philippine Constitution and laws such as Republic act No. 4670, otherwise known as Magana Carta for Public School Teachers.

### What are the objectives of NOPTI?

The objectives of NOPTI are the following:

1. To uphold and enhance the dignity and prestige of the teaching profession and to pursue with constancy and determination the mission and goals of the Philippine educational system as provided for by Philippine Constitution and national priorities.
2. To protect, defend, and advocate the rights, privileges and welfare of professional teachers throughout the country and abroad in the various spheres of their professional life and practice.
3. To lead in the continuing professionalization of teachers and educators services as direct contribution to national development.
4. To participate in the formulation and contact of national, regional and local education policies and programs so as to ensure the continuing relevance of the teaching profession.
5. To establish organizational collaborative linkages and undertake joint activities with other national and international institutions and organizations with similar concerns.

6. To advocate and secure the recognized status and participation of the organization in the various national agencies concerned with professional regulation and development, educational policy making and legislation.

### What benefits and privileges does a NOPTI member enjoy?

- a. Professional development through seminars, workshops, conferences and similar activities
- b. Educational assistance for thesis and dissertation
- c. Nomination as Outstanding Professional Teacher Awardee of the Year
- d. Nomination as Member of the Board for Professional Teachers in the PRC
- e. Assistance in the renewal of professional license
- f. Publications

### Are there teachers who have availed of the NOPTI Educational assistance program?

Yes, a number of them and they were given financial assistance to finish their thesis or dissertation.

### How does NOPTI provide continuing professional education to its members?

NOPTI conducts seminars, workshops and similar activities in coordination with the Board for Professional Teachers and educational institutions.

### How does teacher become a member of NOPTI?

- He /She should have a valid PRC license
- Fills up the official application form
- Pays the membership fee

### How much is the membership?

Members shall pay a one-time membership fee Two Hundred Fifty Pesos (Php 250), payable upon application and an annual due of One Hundred Pesos (Php 100), payable within the first two months of every year thereafter. Teachers who apply for life membership shall pay Five Hundred Pesos (Php 500) each. Life members shall be exempt from paying annual dues.

### To whom shall an applicant pay?

One can pay to an authorized treasurer of the chapter or the authorized representative of NOPTI during the oath-taking ceremonies.

### Where does one apply for membership?

Application form may be obtained from the nearest chapter in the province/ region where an application for membership is stationed.
