Good day! The Award, organized by Alalay sa Pamilya at Bayan (APB), in collaboration with the I Am S.T.R.O.N.G. — I Keep Love Real program of the University of Asia and the Pacific, has been privileged to have Northern Mindanao as a flagship region for its interventions.

Below are the details of the kick-off conference:

- Invited to the kick-off conference for SY 2015-2016 are the 40 high schools that attended the Cachet Schools Award (CSA) last school year. The project is hereby renamed Cachet Saxum Schools Award (the word Saxum, meaning, rock, is a new part of the name of the Award), or CSSA.
- 2. The objectives of the conference are
 - a) to foster team-building through physical and mental activities among the CSSA schools towards greater synergy for this school year;
 - b) to assess the CSSA in-school programs that were carried out in the past school year and provide redirection or enrichment suggestions; and
 - c) to strengthen the participants' appreciation and day-to-day lifestyle implementation of the year's CSSA theme, Chastity and Character: The Guarantee of Wholesome Family Life.
- 3: The three days in the schedule of activities below are referred to as Day One (22 August) to Day Three (24 August). The tentative program is enclosed.

- 4. Requested to attend this three-day activity from each CSSA school (see Annex 1 for roster of CSSA schools) are the following:
 - a. One teacher moderator (see Annex 1);
 - b. The president and vice-president of the Supreme Student Government;
 - c. Three other student leaders and scholars who the school head thinks would be most appropriate for the activities presented below.
- 5. A key part of the conference is the presentation and workshop of the school-based programs, whether managed by the teachers and/or the students, conducted last school year. Hence, we are requesting the schools to submit a report on their programs in a manner they deem most effective for the rest of the participants to learn from or be inspired by.

At the designated time, each school will be allotted five (10) minutes of presentation, if necessary, dividing the 40 schools into four clusters. A workshop in tandem or triad of schools will follow the presentation, culminating in a plenary session for common resolution formulation.
