### 2<sup>ND</sup> INTER-HIGH SCHOOL HISTOLYMPIAD

#### COMPETITION MECHANICS

#### I. GENERAL GUIDELINES

- 1. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Inter-High School HISTOLYMPIAD will be a team competition.
- 2. The questions for the entire contest will cover the field of History (Please see list of topics on the second page). These questions will be from the Committee of the Histolympiad.
- 3. The contestants should be at the place of the competition at least fifteen (15) minutes before the scheduled time.
- 4. Clarifications regarding the rules of the competition shall be entertained by the Committee before the start of the Contest.
- 5. The registration fee is PhP 300 per team. This may be given on the day of the competition.
- 6. The contestants will be provided with pertinent materials needed for the competition.
- 7. Misbehavior of a team during contest, as determined by the proctors, is sufficient condition for disqualification of this team.

#### **II. CONTEST MECHANICS**

- 1. The quizmaster will read each question twice.
- 2. All questions are multiple choices.
- 3. The contestants shall give of their answer after the time allotted has lapsed.
- 4. The guizmaster shall then read the answer to each of the given guestion.
- 5. Any complaint, reaction or inquiry regarding a question and its corresponding answer should be addressed before the next question is given by the quizmaster. Only complains/inquiries from contestants on the stage and their respective coaches may be addressed or entertained. The decision given by the judges is final and is not subject to appeal.

#### A. Elimination Round

- 1. The Elimination Proper shall consist of three (3) rounds: Easy, Average and Difficult round.
- 2. Each round has 10 questions and each question is worth 3 points, 5 points, and 7 points for Easy, Average and Difficult Round respectively.
- 3. Ten, twenty and thirty seconds for the Easy, Average and Difficult round respectively, are allotted per question. The timekeeper will give the signal for the end of the time.
- 4. At the end of this round, the five (5) teams who shall garner the five highest scores shall advance to the Final Round.
- In case of a tie, a tie-breaker question shall be asked and the first team to earn a point is the one that shall qualify to the next round. Series of tie-breaker questions will be given if necessary.

#### B. Final Round

- Points earned by the qualified contestants during the elimination round shall be disregarded.
- 2. The Final Proper shall consist of ten (10) questions wherein each correct answer is equivalent to 10 points.
- 3. At the end of this round, the three finalists with the highest scores shall be declared as the champion, 1st runner up, and 2nd runner up, respectively.
- 4. In case of a tie, a tie-breaker question shall be asked and the first contestant to earn a point is the one who shall win the position being vied for. Series of tie-breaker questions will be given if necessary.

#### III. PARTICIPATING TEAMS

- 1. A team shall be composed of three (3) regular contestants and a coach.
- 2. The contestants must be officially enrolled students in the school they wish to represent.

#### IV. QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. All bonafide students currently enrolled in any private or public schools may join the contest.
- 2. The contestants may be in the form of a team of 3 students regardless of year levels.
- 3. Each school is allowed to send a maximum of (2) teams.
- 4. The participating schools are required to submit their reply slip attached to the letter of invitation on or before August 28, 2015.
- 5. The last day of registration is immediately before the start of the competition (1:00PM). School ID for each participant must be presented during the registration.

#### V. CONFIRMATION OF PARTICIPATION / SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES

Deadline of Confirmation of participation / submission of entries (complete names of the representatives / participants) shall be on or before August 28, 2015 through the filling up and submission of the Participation Form (please see enclosed sheet) to the Department of Social Sciences or via email mesh rivera@gmail.com. #### VI. AWARDS / PRIZES

The Champion, 1<sup>st</sup> runner-up and 2<sup>nd</sup> runner-up will receive cash, medals and Certificate of Recognition.

All participants and participating schools shall each receive a Certificate of Participation.
