Subject: SCALE-UP IMPLEMENTATION OF KALIHOKAN KONTRA KITI-KITI (KKK) IN SCHOOLS AND WORKPLACES

- 1. Responsive to the call of the Local Government Unit through its City Health Officer DR. DENNIS P. SANGALANG, CHO II, this Office supports the call for a unified effort to actively participate in the fight against the deadly Dengue disease. To create awareness through information, education and communication thereby reduce if not eliminate the incidence of this tropical disease, collaboration with LGU/barangay health personnel and other sector is mandated.
- 2. The increasing cases of dengue in some barangays in the locality necessitate a cohesive effort. Hence, School Heads are enjoined to initiate Dengue Control and Prevention advocacy and commence the 4 S' against Dengue DAILY activities, (please refer to enclosed infographics) to be carried out in schools and workplaces.
- 3. Schools shall revitalize the organization of School Dengue Brigade in elementary and secondary schools to serve as prime movers in the implementation and monitoring dengue control and prevention measures. The Dengue Brigade shall be supervised by the School Health and Nutrition Coordinators, Science and MAPEH Teachers.
- Widest dissemination and compliance is desired.
