Subject: DISSEMINATION OF FILARIASIS TRANSMISSION SURVEY

In collaboration with the DOH Transmission Assessment Survey (TAS) in the Province of Bukidnon, a surveillance activity shall be conducted among randomly identified schools in this Division on November 3- 4 and 9, 2015. This activity will be undertaken to determine sustainability of Lymphatic Filariasis Free Zone declaration in the Province of Bukidnon last 2010. The subjects of the survey are schoolchildren ages 6-7 years old in schools listed herein:

This in reference to the scheduled Transmission Assessment Survey (TAS) using Immuno Chromatographic Test (ICT), a necessary surveillance activity that the Province of Bukidnon must undertake this year. The survey will need 3,000 plus children ages 6 – 7 years old as subjects to test whether the province has sustained its status as Lymphatic Filariasis Free Zone since its declaration last June 2010.

The DOH with the RITM, by random sampling, identified schools with its corresponding specific number of students in every city and municipality to comprise the needed 3,000 subjects. During the orientation several months ago, both the Municipal/City Medical Technologists and DepEd Nurses (composition of survey team in every municipality/city) had agreed to partner city/municipal survey team with its neighboring survey team to support each other during the survey.
