MECHANICS

- 1. The search is open to public and private schools nationwide with the following categories: elementary, high school and college. Entries should revolve around the theme: "Sustainable and Eco-Friendly Initiatives of (NAME OF SCHOOL)". Only one entry per school.
- 2. School entries should be rated according to:
 - -Sustainability Aspects of the School's Policy = 10 points
 - -Environmental Dimensions of School Operations = 25 points
 - -Environment-Related Features of the School Curriculum = 25 points
 - -Presence of Vibrant Eco-Organizations in Campus = 10 points
 - -Presence of Environmental Partners and Linkages in Various Programs, Projects an
 - Activities = 10 points
 - -Socio-Cultural Sustainability = 10 points
 - -Economic Sustainability = 10 points
- 3. Special Category 1: The Nestle Water Leadership Award aims to recognize and promote solutions, practices and initiatives of schools in water conservation and management.

The following areas will be considered for the Award:

- Commitments on Water as part of the School's policy
- Long Term and Short Term Objectives
- Resources, Roles, Responsibility and Leadership
- Competence Training and Awareness
- Programs, Initiatives, Projects and Activities
- Menitoring and Measurement
- Periodic review of the program, initiatives, projects and activities
- 4. Special Category 2: The Meralco Energy Leadership Award will recognize schools that promote practices and initiatives in electrical safety, energy efficiency and conservation.

The following areas will be considered for the Award:

- Programs implemented to ensure electrical safety by conducting electrical assessment and measures
- Energy efficiency and conservation programs such as energy saving activities, energy awareness training and leducation, etc.

5. Public elementary and high school entries should be submitted directly to their respective DepEd Division Offices.

Private elementary and high school entries including college (public and private) entries should be submitted to the nearest EMB Regional Offices.

Entries should be submitted in three hard copies, and on-line (www.sustainableschools.ph), or e-mail your entry forms to ecofriendlyschools@gmail.com

The deadline is on April 10, 2015.

The top entry per category will forwarded to the EMB Central Office for national judging.

Previous first second, and third prize winners in the 2009, 2011 and 2013 national search are no longer eligible to join.

Winners will also receive Plaques of Recognition.

Regional Level: Php15,000

National Level: Php20,000 (All Levels)
