**REVISED COMPUTATION OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS' PROPORTIONAL
VACATION PAY (PVP) FOR SCHOOL YEAR (SY) 2014-2015**

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division Superintendents
Heads, Public Elementary and Secondary Schools
All Others Concerned

1. This is to provide the field offices with a uniform basis for the **Revised Computation of the Proportional Vacation Pay (PVP) for School Year (SY) 2014-2015** entitled to all public elementary and secondary school teachers under the teacher's leave basis.


2. For School Year (SY) 2014-2015, each of the teachers who have continuous services from June 2, 2014 to March 27, 2015 shall be entitled to **81 days total of PVP** (instead of 79 days as indicated in DepEd Memorandum No. 34, s. 2015) from Summer and Christmas vacation days, which is recomputed as follows:

Total Number of days served	=	299 days
from June 2, 2014 to March 27, 2015		
Less: Number of Christmas vacation days earned	=	<u>-16 days</u>
from December 22, 2014 to January 2, 2015		
Actual days served	=	283 days
Multiply factor	=	<u>x 0.286</u>
Total PVP earned from the number of Summer and	=	81 days
Christmas vacation days		
Less: Number of Christmas vacation days	=	<u>-16 days</u>
Number of the Summer vacation days earned	=	65 days
from March 28 to June 1, 2015		

3. Factor **0.286** shall be used for the computation of absences and PVP for SY 2014-2015. Below is the derivation of factor **0.286**.

Number of Summer vacation days	=	65 days
Add: Number of Christmas vacation days	=	<u>+16 days</u>
Total PVP	=	81 days
(Summer and Christmas vacation days)		
Divided by actual days served	=	283 days
Multiply factor	=	0.286
