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DIVISION RETOOLING OF TEACHERS AND SCHOOL HEADS SERVING IP COMMUNITIES & WORKSHOP ON INDIGENIZED SONGS AND LEARNING MATERIALS FOR IPED IMPLEMENTATION

- 1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 62, s. 2011 on Adopting the Indigenous Peoples' Education Policy Framework which focuses on the IP Rights, which is an integral part of the K-12 Program that gives primary importance to the principles of participation, inclusion and empowerment, the Division of Malaybalay City will conduct a Division Training/Retooling of Teachers and School Heads on Indigenized Learning Materials and Songs for IPEd Implementation on May 27-29, 2015. (venue to be announced later)
- 2. The activity aims to serve as forum for teachers and school heads to conduct a workshop on indigenized learning materials and songs as well as reorientation on DepEd Order No. 62 s. 2011 known as the Indigenous Peoples' Education Policy Framework. Furthermore, the stakeholders are expected to make a commitment of support to Indigenous Peoples Education Program.
- Participants of the training/retooling are the school heads and select IP teachers of the following schools: Baganao ES, Caburacanan ES, Can-ayan IS, Candisan ES, Dalwangan ES, Kalasungay CS, Kapitan Angel ES, Kibalabag ES (N), Kilap-agan ES, Kulaman ES, Manalog ES, Patpat ES, St. Peter ES, Silae ES, Tag-ilanao ES, Tintinaan ES & Mapayag ES; NCIP; Division Office TWG/ PSDS (North & Far East), & Support staff.
- 4. Meals and materials for the activity and lodging for tribal elders and facilitators will be charged to IPEd Funds and travel expenses will be charged to local/school funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
