

1. In support of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) and the Department of Education (DepEd) which was signed on February 9, 2013, the NCCA through its Philippine Cultural Education Program (PCEP) and the Arts Research and Training Institute in Southern Tagalog (ARTIST) Inc., in collaboration with *Linang* Arts and Culture Network Inc. and the University of the Philippines Los Baños (UPLB), Laguna, announces the conduct of *Malikhaing Guro* Second International Conference on Culture-Based Education from September 9-12, 2015 at the University of the Philippines Los Baños (UPLB), Laguna.

2. The Conference aims to:

- a. gather cultural educators, pedagogues, cultural workers, and arts practitioners across nations and surface their various practices, emerging perspectives, and challenges to the different modalities of education anchored on culture; and
- b. highlight the different experiences in culture-based education in Asia-Pacific and those from the member-countries of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN).
- 3. The Conference shall consist of plenary sessions, parallel paper presentations and workshop demonstrations. The *Conference Design* is detailed in Enclosure No.1, while the *Call for Participation* is provided in Enclosure No. 2.
