#### 2015 NATIONAL DISABILITY PREVENTION AND REHABILITATION WEEK

To:

Bureau Directors Regional Directors Schools Division Superintendents Heads Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

- The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE)-Special Education (SPED) Division, Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) and the Bureau of Alternative Learning System (BALS), will celebrate the 2015 National Disability Prevention and Rehabilitation Week which starts on July 17 and culminates on July 23, 2015, the birth anniversary of Apolinario Mabini, the Sublime Paralytic.
- 2. This is pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 361, s. 2000 entitled Declaring the Third Week of July as the National Prevention and Rehabilitation Week, and Administrative Order No. 35, s. 2002, entitled Declaring All Departments, Bureaus, Government-Owned and/or Controlled Corporations, Government Financial Institutions, Local Government Units, State College and Universities, and Other Government Agencies, Instrumentalities to Promote and Conduct Relevant Activities During the Annual Observance of the National Disability Prevention and Rehabilitation (NDPR) Week.
- This year's celebration is anchored on the theme Health and Wellness Opportunities for Persons with Disabilities Towards an Inclusive Development of All, which aims to promote and advocate quality health care services for persons with disabilities (PWDs).

#### 4. The Celebration aims to:

- a. stimulate public awareness on disability issues and concerns which will strengthen the involvement of the government and non-government offices (NGOs) including cause-oriented groups, civil society, self-help groups of PWDs, the academe, professional groups and societies, local government units (LGUs), business sector, the media and other entities of the society;
- b. serve as the vehicle of information for programs which are being implemented by government agencies and organizations of and for PWDs and which adhere to the promotion of the inherent rights and concerns of PWDs;
- c. encourage every Filipino citizen to take active responsibility in uplifting the economic and social conditions of PWDs in the society, thereby encouraging them to take pro-active roles in nation-building;
- d. generate full media support on the celebration and on other disabilityrelated issues and concerns that affect PWDs and their families; and
- develop and strengthen cooperation and partnership between and among the various sectors of the Philippine society for better understanding of disability issues and concerns.

- 5. As a member of the NCDA [National Council Development Authority] Governing Board, DepEd enjoins field offices and all schools, most especially SPED centers, public and private schools with SPED programs to undertake activities relevant to the theme of this year's celebration. The schools may select activities among those organized by NCDA as provided in Enclosure No. 1. They are also requested to hang streamers following the format provided in Enclosure No. 2.
- 6. However, these should not disrupt classes nor compromise their supervision pursuant to DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*
- 7. Relative to the celebration of the NDPR Week, all SPED centers and schools with SPED programs must accomplish the enclosed Agency Feedback Report Form (Enclosure No. 3) to be submitted to the SPED Division, BEE, DepEd Central Office or through email at sped\_bee.deped@yahoo.com.
- 8.
