



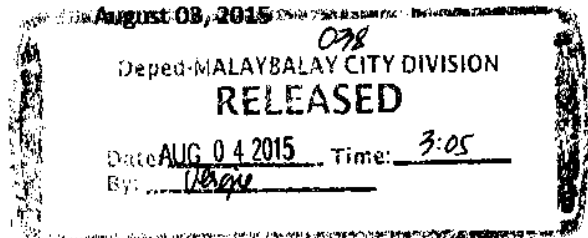

We are opening a graduate program in Culture and Arts (C&A) Studies, a pioneering course that has grown out of the need to develop scholars, managers, teachers, and practitioners in our creative environment.

The course is relevant to all those involved with the Creative Industry, education in all levels, performing groups, artists of any genre, human resource and events management, and related fields. Career opportunities are encouraging especially with the growing Creative Industry touting to be a formidable economic cornerstone of the 21st century.

As a "ladderized" course, the C&A Studies enhances the creative, production, and management skills of students in their engagements with creative-oriented activities. - **Personal Statement.** Succinctly summarize reasons for applying to this program. Why are you interested to join this graduate program? What purpose will this degree serve in your long-term professional goal? In your engagements with your community? What qualities do you possess to be admitted to the program? In what ways will you contribute to the program and the artistic community you represent? Include a description of your background, tentative plan of study, and a list of your interests.

PRE-ACCEPTANCE PROJECT / THESIS PROPOSAL

program covers culture studies, the arts, and the Creative Industry. It requires that a **proposal** be sent to a panel before any student is accepted, which includes:

proposal determines the courses students take through any of the three tracks of the program: *Performance Studies*, *Creative Writing and Literature*, and *Arts Administration*.

RESEARCH-READINESS

The applicant may opt for a research-directed program rather than a track that explores creation. Any of the three tracks may cover such a research-directed orientation. (For example, in a *Performance Studies* track, a student may opt to study performance as manifestations of spirituality in a community, opting for research rather than a creative production like a recital.)

In this case, the PG and panel may seek other qualifications to evaluate the preparedness of the applicants through various evidences to determine their ability to think critically and to articulate research. Evidences may include the quality of an undergraduate thesis, average grade in major courses, background studies, experience, and the like.
