

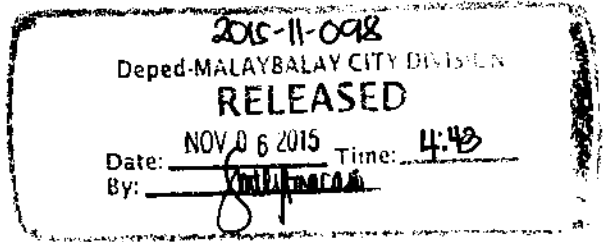

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) Region X, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) announces the conduct of the **2015 Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC)** with the theme, *The Role of 21st Century Campus Journalists in Upholding Good Governance, Leadership and Transparency* from November 30-December 2, 2015 in Oroquieta City, Division of Oroquieta City.

2. The conference aims to achieve the following objectives:

- Demonstrate understanding on the importance of journalism by expressing it through different journalistic endeavors and approaches;
- Sustain advocacy on social consciousness;
- Provide a venue for an enriching learning experience for learners interested in pursuing journalism as a career;
- Promote responsible journalism and fair ethical use of social media; and
- Enhance journalistic competence through healthy and friendly competition.

3. The activities will include eight (8) Individual Writing Contests including Science and Health; Scriptwriting and Radio Broadcasting Contests; and Collaborative Publishing Contest; Non-Contestants' Activities; Awarding of Winners including those in the 2015 National Schools Press Conference in Taguig City.

4. Participants are the Top Three Winners of the Division Schools Press Conference except for the Scriptwriting and Radiobroadcasting and Collaborative Publishing Contest where only the Top Group per level and category is allowed to join, coaches/advisers, Division EPS in English and Filipino, Chiefs of the CID and CLMD, Board of Judges and the Technical Working Group of the Region and Division.

5. Division Journalism Coordinators are requested to coordinate and submit to CID Chief Francis Buac of the host division @ 0917 575 5931 the **number of participants on or before October 9, 2015** as disseminated through text message. Divisions which fail to submit the accurate number of participants will have to arrange their own caterers during the conduct of RSPC.

6. A registration fee of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P 1,500.00) and other traveling expenses of participants shall be charged against school/local/division/SEF or school journalism funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures. The registration fee shall be used to defray expenses on board and lodging, kits, materials, trophy, medal and honorarium of the board of judges and the Two Hundred Pesos (P 200.00) from this amount shall be used to subsidize the

registration fee of the regional winners to the national competition to be held on February 22-26, 2016 to be hosted by Region XII. Payment of registration must be deposited to DepEd Division of Oroquieta City at Land Bank account number **1292-1082-61** with the deposit slip to be faxed to **0885310831** in order to proceed to online registration via this link: geocities.ws/depedoroquieta/rspc. Walk-in registrants are not allowed.

7. Student-Delegates must be certified to be in good health and must have written permission from parent/guardian. The delegation head shall collect all permits in that Division and submit to the RSPC Secretariat upon registration. Every participating school is also required to submit the latest issue of school publication. All participants are advised to bring off lotion.

8. All delegations are expected to arrive on November 30, 2015. The host Division has arranged with the management of Daima Shipping Corporation to accommodate in priority all buses of participants to the conference. The delegation head is advised to coordinate with the contact numbers of the school-billeting quarter found in the enclosure.

9. In order to clarify issues and concerns regarding the conduct of the Schools Press Conferences, a **meeting of Division Journalism Coordinators will be done on October 30, 2015**. Concerned officials, officers in charge of RSPC, personnel, staff, and pupils/students are also advised to refer to the implementing guidelines stipulated in DepEd Order No. 47, s. 2010. The guidelines of the Individual and Group Contests per DepEd Memorandum No. 9, s. 2014 (Enclosure Nos. 3 to 7 and Guidelines on the Search for Outstanding Campus Journalists and School Paper Advisers (elementary and secondary) shall still be followed.

10. Included in this memorandum are the following enclosures: 1 – format on the List of Student-contestants and Regional School Paper Entries; 2 – Matrix of Activities; 3- Membership Fees; 4 – Billeting Quarters and Contest Venues. Contest rules in the previous year's RSPC are still to be followed.

11. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
