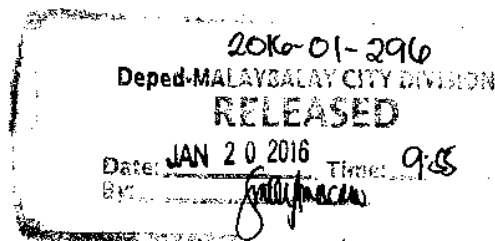

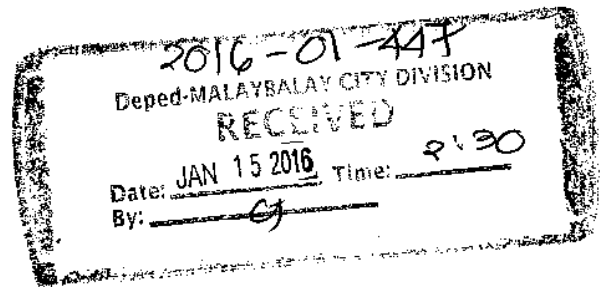

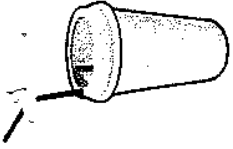

CLIMATE CHANGE IMPACT

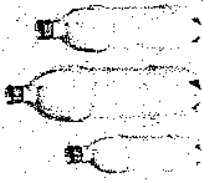
HEALTH IMPACT

- * irrigation demands



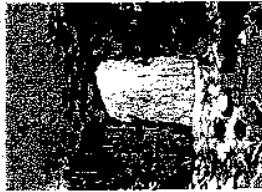
FOREST IMPACT
