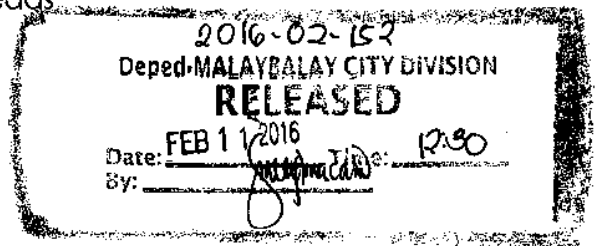

1. For the information and guidance of all concerned, this office hereby disseminates the herein enclosed DepEd Memorandum No. 21, s 2016 dated February 10, 2016 re: "**ANNOUNCING THE 2016 METROBANK SEARCH FOR MOST OUTSTANDING TEACHERS**" the content of which is self-explanatory.
2. Elementary School heads are entitled to nominate two teachers: One for the primary (Kinder to grade 3) and intermediate (grades 4-6) while secondary school head is entitled to nominate only one teacher.
3. The nominee should accomplish a two-page Basic Information Sheet (BIS) without attachment yet (Supporting Documents) attached to this memo or download from mbfoundation.org or via online form through facebook page (FB/mbfi.sot).
4. The accomplished BIS should be submitted to Metrobank Malaybalay Branch Fortich Street, Malaybalay City on or before **February 14, 2016**. Copy furnished to the Division Office attention: **Vicente G. San Miguel, EPS II-HRD**.

SUBJECT: 2016 METROBANK FOUNDATION SEARCH FOR OUTSTANDING TEACHERS

DATE: February 5, 2016

1. The Metrobank Foundation, Inc. (MBFI), in cooperation with the Department of Education (DepEd), announces the launching of the **2016 Search for Outstanding Teachers**. Now on its 32nd year, the Search has awarded a total of 346 outstanding teachers from public and private schools all over the country.
2. The Search bestows honor upon the teaching profession by according special recognition to teachers who manifest profound commitment to the development of the youth through exemplary competence, remarkable dedication to their work and effective educational leadership.
3. The Search is open to teachers who are Filipino citizens teaching in the elementary, secondary or tertiary levels, including alternative learning system, with full-time or permanent appointment and with full-load. Nominees should have been actively teaching in the Philippines for the last 10 years (inclusive of leaves not exceeding three years, provided the nominee is not on leave, i.e., actually teaching at the time of nomination). However, the nominee must not be on leave for more than two years immediately prior to nomination.
4. Nominees must be teachers with valid PRC license.

5. Average performance ratings for the last five (5) years should at least be "Very Satisfactory" with no rating below "Satisfactory". For those who have been on official/study leave or on secondment, performance ratings for five years closest to the period of nomination should be provided.
6. Elementary schools are entitled to nominate two nominees, one each for the primary (kinder to grade III) and intermediate (grade IV to grade VI) while high schools are entitled to nominate only one teacher each.
7. **Joining the Search is now easier!** Nominees just need to accomplish a 2-page **Basic Information Sheet (BIS)** with **NO** attachments yet. The form is available for download from the Metrobank Foundation website (mbfoundation.org), at the DepEd Division Office or via online form through facebook page ([FB/mbfi.sot](https://www.facebook.com/mbfi.sot)). The hardcopy accomplished BIS should be submitted to any Metrobank Branch nearest the nominee's school or send via courier to Metrobank Foundation, 4th Floor, Executive Offices, Metrobank Plaza, Sen. Gil J. Puyat Avenue, Makati City on or before the extended deadline of **February 14, 2016**. *There is no need to submit nomination form and supporting documents yet.*
8. The nominees must be officially endorsed by principals, head teachers or school heads, who are the only ones authorized to nominate teachers to the Search. For DepEd Schools without principals, the Teachers-in-Charge (TIC) can nominate, but the Schools Division Superintendents (SDS) must endorse the nomination. Head Teachers (HTs), TICs, Assistant Principals are eligible to join the Search, provided they carry a teaching load of at least 50% of the total load required by the nominating school for full-time faculty. However, they should be endorsed by any of the Division/District Supervisors and the Schools Division Superintendents concerned should be the official nominators.
9. Winners of other Searches/awards for outstanding teachers conducted by reputable organizations at the regional, national and international levels are deemed **Automatic Provincial Finalists**, provided they meet the basic eligibility requirements of tenure, performance, and teaching load and passed levels of screening. Awards to be considered are only those at the level a particular nominee is being nominated. Moreover, nominees must go through the usual nomination process and submit the duly accomplished BIS and nomination form on or before the deadline.
10. Past Regional Finalists and National Finalists of the Search, who meet the basic eligibility requirements and have shown sustained good moral standing in the community are deemed **automatic Provincial Finalists**. As a privilege and to give premium to them, there is **NO** need to submit their nomination form immediately on February 22, 2016. Instead, they will submit it together with their supporting documents which are due on **April 25, 2016**. However, to make their nomination official, they still need to submit their duly accomplished BIS on **January 30, 2016**.

1. **Each DepEd division is directed to generate a minimum of five (5) nominations and to encourage principals to nominate their best bets.** Screening at the division level however is not necessary. To report on the compliance, Metrobank Foundation will submit a list of DepEd divisions that meet the target of 5 nominations to the Office of the Secretary for his record.
2. **Good news!** The foundation has increased the cash prizes from P350,000 to P500,000 for each of the 10 awardees, part of which will go to the school for faculty development program. National finalists will receive P20,000, while regional finalists who will not make it as winners will receive P10,000.
3. Other details on the Search are contained in the Guidelines together with the official Search BIS, which can be obtained from the Metrobank Foundation official website, MBFI Search for Outstanding Teachers official Facebook Page, as well as, DepEd Regional and Division offices nationwide.

1. The Metrobank Foundation Inc. (MBFI), in cooperation with the Department of Education (DepEd), announces the launching of the **2016 Search for Outstanding Teachers**. On its 32nd year, the Search has awarded a total of 346 outstanding teachers from public and private schools nationwide.
2. The Search bestows honor upon the teaching profession by according special recognition to teachers who manifest profound commitment to the development of the youth through exemplary competence, remarkable dedication to their work and effective educational leadership.
3. The Search is open to teachers who are Filipino citizens teaching at the elementary, secondary or tertiary levels, including alternative learning system, with full-time or permanent appointment and with full-load. Nominees should have been actively teaching in the Philippines for the last ten years, inclusive of leaves not exceeding three years, provided that the nominee is not on leave, (i.e. actually teaching at the time of nomination). However, the nominee must not be on leave for more than two years immediately prior to nomination.
4. Nominees must be teachers with valid Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) license.
5. Their average performance ratings for the last five years should be at least *Very Satisfactory* with no rating below *Satisfactory*. For those who have been on official/study leave or on secondment, performance ratings for five years closest to the period of nomination should be provided.
6. Elementary school heads (SHs) are entitled to nominate two teachers: one each for the primary (Kinder to Grade 3) and intermediate (Grades 4 to 6), while each high school head is entitled to nominate only one teacher.
7. Nominees need to accomplish a two-page Basic Information Sheet (BIS) *without attachments yet*. The form is downloadable on Metrobank Foundation website: mbfoundation.org and at the DepEd schools division offices (SDOs) or through Facebook page: [FB/mbfi.sot](https://www.facebook.com/mbfi.sot).
8. The hardcopy accomplished BIS should be submitted to any Metrobank Branch nearest the nominee's school or sent via courier to Metrobank Foundation, 4th Floor, Executive Offices, Metrobank Plaza, Sen. Gil J. Puyat Avenue, Makati City



on or before **February 14, 2016**. *There is no need to submit a nomination form and supporting documents.*

9. The nominees must be officially endorsed by the school principals/heads or head teachers (HTs) who are the only ones authorized to nominate teachers to the Search. For DepEd schools without school principals, teachers-in-charge (TICs) can nominate, but the schools-division superintendents (SDSs) must endorse the nomination. The HTs, TICs, assistant school principals are eligible to join the Search provided they carry a teaching load of at least 50% of the total load required by the nominating school for full-time faculty. However, they should be endorsed by any of the schools division/district supervisors, and the SDSs concerned should be the official nominators.

10. Winners of other searches/awards for outstanding teachers conducted by reputable organizations at the regional, national and international levels are deemed *automatic provincial finalists*, provided that they meet the basic eligibility requirements of tenure, performance and teaching load and passed the different levels of screening. Awardees to be considered are only those at the level of a particular nominee. Moreover, nominees must go through the usual nomination process and submit the duly accomplished BIS and nomination form on or before the deadlines.

11. Past regional finalists and national finalists of the Search who meet the basic eligibility requirements and have shown sustained good moral standing in the community, are deemed *automatic provincial finalists*. As a privilege and to give premium to them, there is *no need* to submit their respective accomplished nomination forms immediately on **February 22, 2016**. Instead, they will submit the accomplished form together with their supporting documents which are due on **April 25, 2016**. However, to make their nominations official, they still need to submit their duly accomplished BIS on **January 30, 2016**.

12. *Each DepEd SDO is directed to generate a minimum of five nominations and to encourage schools principals to nominate their best candidates.* However, screening at the school division level is not necessary. To report on the compliance, the MBFI will submit a list of DepEd SDOs which met the target of five nominations to the Office of the Secretary for his record.

13. The Foundation has increased the cash prizes from P 350,000.00 to P 500,000.00 for each of the ten awardees, part of which will go to the school for faculty development program. Each of the national finalists will receive P 20,000.00, while each of the regional finalists who will not make it as winners will receive P 10,000.00.
