

- 1. Consistent with the constitutional right to self-organization of civil servants and the guidelines issued on this matter under Executive Order No. 180, all public school teachers and other non-teaching personnel must be provided with relevant and adequate information on the legal bases of public sector unionism. This includes the information on their benefits or advertages derived from their active participation in the union to protect their interests which lead to the delivery of a more effective, efficient and dependable services to the general public.
- Public fore initiated by any duly registered public sector employees' organization for the purpose of orienting the teaching and non-teaching personnel on the foregoing matters should be supported and encouraged.
- 3. Accordingly, all school principals and schools superintendents shall allow teachers and even non-teaching personnel to participate in any public employees' organization sponsored seminar upon proper leave from school authorities provided that such activities shall not prejudice or disrupt the public service, in particular education related programs and

We welcome 2016 faced with various issues concerning teaching profession. As your true voice in the House of Representatives, we actively fight to alleviate the sad plight of teachers by increasing their monthly salaries. With the paltry increases granted by SSL 2015, teachers' salaries are still inadequate to meet the cost of living for their families and very far from our demands of at least P25,000 for Teacher I, and motivate teachers to seek more lucrative employment abroad rather than encourage them to teach Filipino children here in our country.


Also among our legislative priorities is to inform teachers of their rights regarding Public Sector Unionism as implemented by DepEd Order No. \$1, s. 2003 "Teacher Orientation to Public Unionism." According to this Order, "all public school teachers and non-teaching personnel must be provided with relevant and adequate Information on the legal bases of public sector unionism" and "all school principals and schools superintendents shall allow teachers and even non-teaching personnel to participate in any public employees' organization sponsored seminar." Aiming to represent all public elementary and high school teachers in the region, ACT Region X Union is now in the process of gathering signatures for the purpose of its accreditation.

in view of the above, this Representation would like to seek your assistance as we plan to conduct the 2nd Batch of Clustered Consultation on these topics on September 13-15, 2016, by issuing a memorandum encouraging the attendance of at least two teachers, pref trably faculty club presidents and secretaries in every school, province, division and school district wide officers in your division.
