20TH NATIONAL AUTISM CONSCIOUSNESS WEEK

1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 711 dated January 4, 1996 entitled *Declaring the Third Week of January as Autism Consciousness Week*, the Department of Education (DepEd), through the Special Education (SPED) Division, Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE), will celebrate the **20th National Autism Consciousness Week** from January 17 to 23, 2016 with the theme *Onwards to an Autism-OK Philippines*.

2. The Celebration aims to:

- a. generate awareness, acceptance and understanding, inclusion and employment of people with autism in society; and
- b. promote action by public and private sectors towards enabling people with autism to live with dignity, enjoy equal rights and access to education, services and facilities enjoyed by the nondisabled people for them to function independently and contribute productively to the society.

3. Public and private schools with programs for children with autism and SPED centers are encouraged to undertake the following activities, provided that the *no-disruption-of-classes policy* stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*, shall be observed:

- a. Hanging of streamers (format enclosed);
- b. Conduct of *1Bansa, 1Pangako* Campaign (toolkit can be downloaded from <http://bit.ly/1bansa1pangako>);
- c. Conduct of Quiz "A";
 - i. Quiz A1 for children with autism focused on an Academic Area; and
 - ii. Quiz A2 for pupils and students in the regular classes focused on knowledge and information about autism;
- d. Indigenous painting activities/contests;
- e. Folk dance and singing activities/contests;
- f. *Larong Pinoy* (*piko, patintero, sepak-takraw, palo-sebo, taguan*, among other games);
- g. Consultation with possible employers of people with autism;
- h. Parents' counseling activities on the why's of autism;
- i. Disaster preparedness and response activities for people with autism; and
- j. Week-long exhibit on educational services offered to children with autism.

4. All concerned schools in the National Capital Region, Region IV-A (CALABARZON), and other interested schools may participate in the following activities:
