

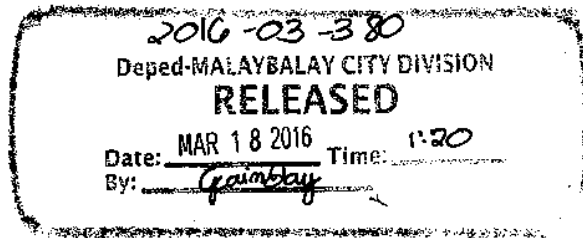

Greetings!

The Philippine Science High School – Main Campus (PSHS-MC) will celebrate its 19th Youth Math, Science, and Technology (YMSAT) Festival on 25-29 April 2016. This year's Festival has adopted the theme "Science and Technology in the Service of Society." In recognition of the critical role played by science and technology in nation-building.

In line with this, we are inviting upper elementary and secondary school students, teachers, and education professionals to participate in our YMSAT OPEN 2016. The schedule and activities are as follows:

Secondary school students (Grades 7-10) and educators (April 27, Wednesday)

1. **Interscholastic Science Congress (ISC)** – will feature a plenary session in the morning and various teacher and student workshops in the afternoon. Each school may send a maximum of seven students and two teachers. The registration fee is PHP100 per student from private schools and PHP50 per student from public schools. Teachers are free of charge.
2. **Interschool Integrated Science Olympiad (IISO)** – an inter-high school competition that focuses on the application of science and technology through hands-on activities. Each school may send a maximum of two teams with each team composed of three Grade 9/10/fourth year students and a teacher-chaperone/coach. There is no registration fee.
3. **Computron Interschool IT Challenge (CIIC)** – a whole-day inter-high school competition that tests the skills, knowledge, and abilities of students in information technology. Each school may send a maximum of two teams with each team composed of two Grade 7/8 students and a teacher-chaperone/coach. There is no registration fee.
4. **Catalyst 2016** – a whole-day seminar on best practices in education technology for secondary school teachers. Each school may send a maximum of five teachers to participate in the event. The registration fee is PHP300 per participant and is inclusive of kits, meals, and snacks.
5. Various interactive exhibits in science, mathematics, technology, and research.

Elementary school students (Grades 5 and 6) and educators (April 28, Thursday)

1. **Interscholastic Science Congress (ISC)** – will feature a plenary session in the morning and various teacher and student workshops in the afternoon. Each school may send a maximum of seven students and two teachers. The registration fee is PHP100 per student from private schools and PHP50 per student from public schools. Teachers are free of charge.
2. **Togikan ng mga Mathematik (Tagisan)** – a whole-day interscholastic competition that seeks to challenge the mathematical ability and creativity of students and foster interaction among mathematically talented grade school students. Each school may send one team composed of one Grade 5 and one Grade 6 student and a teacher-chaperone/coach. There is no registration fee.
3. Various interactive exhibits in science, mathematics, technology, and research.
