SCALE-UP IMPLEMENTATION OF ESSENTIAL HEALTH CARE
PROGRAM IN SY 2016 2017

- 1. In preparation for the implementation of Division program and projects in SY 2016-2017, this Office reiterates Regional Memorandum no. 36 s. 2014 re: Call for Commitment on the implementation of Essential Health Care Program (EHCP) for the Schoolchildren and in relation to all feeding program/projects in Public Elementary Schools in this Region.
- 2. Along this context, all Elementary School Heads are advised to withdraw and receive the City Government funded EHCP supplies from the Division SGOD Health-Section, through the District nurses starting June 7-10,2016. These EHCP materials for Kinder Grade VI shall serve part of the Hygiene Kit as stipulated in DM 35,s. 2016-IMPLEMENTING BRIGADA ESKWELA 2016 Enclosure 1-Annex C.
- 3. To scale –up implementation of this program, Division Program Supervisors M/E, PSDSs and health personnel shall see to it that a functional Essential Health Care Program is implemented in the schools. Moreover, School Heads are directed to do the following:
- Provide a functional handwashing and toothbrushing facility (indoor or outdoors) with available water supply
 - Institutionalize daily EHCP activity as reflected in the Daily Class Program.
- Intensify advocacy on Bi-annual deworming among schoolchildren and students every January and July to increase percentage of coverage.
- 4. Immediate dissemination and compliance with this memorandum is desired.
