- 2. The Congress aims to:
  - a. enhance the participants' capacities on the promotion and delivery of School Health and Support Services Programs through discussion and sharing of best practices;
  - b. identify critical issues, gaps and concerns and formulate recommendations/solutions
  - c. discuss the present health and important issues in the region/division and recommend effective health interventions;
  - d. foster camaraderie between and among health and Support Program workers from various sectors and forge commitments and grand alliance for school health and support programs; and
  - e. develop Action Plan for School Year 2016-2017
- Considering the relevance and importance of this Congress towards the effective delivery of the programs, the following officials shall attend on official business:
