

<p>About the Organizer</p>	<p>Northeast Normal University (NENU) is an institution of higher learning under the direct administration of the Ministry of Education of China, being selected as one of the universities given priority in construction in the "211 Project".</p> <p>NENU has maintained a long history and offered study in a full range of subject areas. NENU is presently composed of 22 schools, 59 specialty fields of study for undergraduates, and a graduate school, which offers M.A. degree in 151 subjects/specialties, and Ph.D. degree in 111 subjects/ specialties. There are 34 first-grade specialties authorized to confer M.A. Degrees, and 22 first-grade specialties authorized to confer Ph.D. degree.</p> <p>NENU has 16 disciplines with Post-doctoral R&D Stations, a doctor degree program for Doctors of Education and 17 professional M.A. degrees in Education. 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Jilin University (JLU), located in Changchun, the capital city of Jilin Province in Northeastern China, is a leading national university under the direct jurisdiction of the Ministry of Education of China. JLU was among the first universities approved by the National Education Commission "Project 211" in 1995, and one of the national key universities of "Project 985" in 2001.

Jilin University (JLU) is a comprehensive university with 13 academic disciplines, including philosophy, economics, law, education, literature, history, science, engineering, agriculture, medicine, administration, military science and art. JLU offers a variety of degree programs.
