

Northeast Normal University (NENU) is an institution of higher learning under the direct administration of the Ministry of Education of China, being selected as one of the universities given priority in construction in the "211 Project".

NENU has maintained a long history and offered study in a full range of subject areas. NENU is presently composed of 22 schools, 59 specially fields of study for undergraduates, and a graduate school, which offers M.A. degree in 151 subjects/specialties, and Ph.D. degree in 111 subjects/ specialties. There are 34 first-grade specialties authorized to confer M.A. Degrees, and 22 first-grade specialties authorized to confer Ph.D. degree.

NENU has 16 disciplines with Post-doctoral R&D Stations, a doctor degree program for Doctors of Education and 17 professional M.A. degrees in Education. Five subjects have been listed as second-grade key disciplines of the National Institution.
