The Guro Formation Forum (GFF) will be conducting the 2016 International Conference-Workshop (ICW) for Teachers and Administrators with the theme "Strategenis and Modalities of Learning Outcomes across Disciplines" on 27-29 October 2016 at the Tagaytay Country Hotel, Olivarez Plaza, E. Aguinaldo Highway, Tagaytay City, Philippines. The goal of the activity is to equip the participants with much needed knowledge and skills to develop outcome-based learning tasks that measure students' self-monitored understanding of various contents in different subject areas or disciplines.

Part of the major activities lined up for the ICW is a series of concurrent sessions wherein a total of 35 research papers will be presented. In this light, the GFF invites the DepEd to submit at least 5 to 8 papers for presentation—the topics of and standards for which are detailed on the GFF website (<https://guroformationforum.org/>).

Abstracts are to be sent by email in Microsoft Word format using Arial font, size 12, single spaced, directly to guroformation@yahoo.com not later than 15 September 2016. Final manuscripts are due on 22 September 2016. The official language of the conference is English.
