

Pursuant to the enclosed National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC) Memorandum No. 46, s. 2016 entitled Conduct of CY 2016, 3rd Quarter Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED) and the unnumbered memorandum sent by the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS) last September 2, 2016, the Department of Education (DepEd), instructs all regional and division offices to remind all schools in their respective area of responsibility to ensure all the necessary preparations for the said activity are completed.

In the same regard, as part of the additional preparedness measures for schools, the DRRMS reiterates the conduct of Promoting Family Earthquake Preparedness, and follow all its guidelines and procedures, as indicated in DepEd Order (DO) No. 27, s. 2015.

Following are the activities for implementation, as stated in the DO:

- All learners shall be required to accomplish the family earthquake preparedness homework (refer
 to Enclosures 1-4 from the DO) with their families and submit it to their class advisers;
- All advisers shall discuss each of the questions with the students along with their family's responses to the homework using the guidance notes (Enclosure 5) during the homeroom session;
- 3. All class advisers shall tabulate and summarize the answers on the family earthquake preparedness assessment questions and submit it to the school administration; and
- 4. All school heads shall discuss and present the results to the Parents-Teachers Association (PTA) and barangay officials for consideration in the school and community preparedness planning.

All reports must be submitted by the school heads via SMS through 09288718053 or 09151789312, following this format: School ID, Date of Completion (dd-mm-yyyy), Name of School Head, Position [ex. 123456,02-08-2016, Juan dela Cruz, Principal IV).
