

- 1. Pursuant to the herein DepEd Memorandum No. 169, s. 2016 re: One Million Lapis Campaign, you are hereby enjoined to support the Council for the Welfare of Children (CWC) advocacy campaign entitled, One Million Lapis.
- It is reiterated that all schools shall be guided by DepEd Order No. 41. \pm s. 2012 or the No. 2. Collection Policy. The collection of pencils must be on a voluntary basis only and must not be mandatory nor become a school requirement. All donated pencils shall be forwarded to this Office. Attention: Marsfifth M. Mamawag, EPS II (Social Mobilization) on or before October 21, 2016 which shall then be forwarded to the Regional Office on October 26, 2016 for storage and documentation of the Regional Focal Person.
- Further, All schools are advised to provide (1) drop box with logo and details of the 3. campaign; (2) designate a safekeeping/storage area of the collected/donated pencils (3) monitor the collection of pencils (Enclosure no.2 of DepEd Memo No. 169); (4) document the progress of the campaign; (5) submit the monitoring form to this Office; (6) Coordinate the SDO on the details of the campaign.
- Final counting and official declaration of all the pencils collected will be done during the kick-off activity of the 2016 National Children's Month Celebration.

ONE MILLION LAPIS CAMPAIGN

- 1. The Council for the Welfare of Children (CWC) is the focal government interagency body mandated to formulate policies and plans, monitor the implementation and enforcement of laws to protect and promote children's rights by virtue of Presidential Decree No. 603, otherwise known as the Child and Youth Welfare Code. As one of the major activities of the National Children's Month this November, the Department of Education (DepEd) supports the CWC's advocacy campaign entitled, One Million Lapis.
- 2. The One Million Lapts Campaign aims to collect one million pencils to be given to underprivileged children in elementary schools of the 4th to 6th class municipalities of the country. These children lack the opportunity to pursue schooling and necessary materials for writing. A documentary in 2012 showed that children in far-flung villages of the country divide one pencil into three to be used for writing. Moreover, this campaign also envisions to enter the Guinness World Record for the longest line of pencils.
- 3. In support to this, all DepEd Offices-Central Office (CO), Regional Offices (ROs) and Schools Division Offices (SDOs) and all public and private schools in the country are hereby enjoined to participate in the campaign. All DepEd personnel and staff must be guided by DepEd Order No. 41, s. 2012 or the No Collection Policy. Collection of pencils must be done on a voluntary basis only and must not be mandatory nor become a school requirement.

In addition, DepEd personnel and staff may invite their partners from non-government organizations, parent-teachers associations, and other members of the community or the private sector to donate pencils for the Campaign. Donation of pencils for the Campaign will be done until October 26, 2016.

- 4. All ROs shall designate the Regional Partnership Focal Person (RPFP) to lead and monitor the collection of pencils for the campaign. The RPFP shall:
 - a ensure that a drop box be made available in each RO and SDO, with the logo and details of the campaign as specified in Enclosure No. 1;
 - b. designate a storage area in the RO for the pencils which will be collected from the SDOs and schools;
 - c. monitor the collection of pencils through the Monitoring Form provided in Enclosure No. 2;
 - d. document the progress of the Campaign through photos and/or videos:
 - e. submit the said Monitoring Form to the External Partnerships Service (EPS) for recording, and;
 - f. coordinate with the EPS on the details of the Campaign.
- 5. Pencils collected from the SDOs and schools shall be sent to the RO for storage and documentation of the Focal Person.
- 6. For the CO, the drop box for the One Million Lapis Campaign is available at the EPS Office, located at the Ground Floor, Rizal Building. All DepEd CO employees in all bureaus, services, and offices are encouraged to donate and participate in the Campaign.
- 7. Final counting and official declaration of all the pencils collected will be done during the kick-off activity of the 2016 National Children's Month Celebration. The turnover of all the pencils to DepEd will be on November 20, 2016 during the Araw ng Kabataan program as culminating activity of the National Children's Month.
- 8. All RPFPs are requested to provide a list of schools from the 4th to 6th class municipalities of the regions and the number of Grades 1 to 3 pupils in each school. This will serve as basis for the distribution of pencils collected from the Campaign. The list shall be submitted to the EPS Office on or before **October 26**, **2016** through the contact details provided below.
