


The Republic Act no. 10742 (Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015), Chapter 3, Section 23 stated that there shall be in every province, city and municipality a Local Youth Development Council (LYDC) "which shall be called, Provincial Youth Development Council, City Youth Development Council and Municipal Youth Development Council, respectively. This was created to ensure wide and multi-sectoral youth participation in local governance with the vision of making our city livable, workable, learnable, playable, and givable through our youth.

Further, Section 30 of Chapter VI of this act also mandated the observance of Linggo ng Kabataan, which should be conducted annually.



Dancing Acts Mechanics and Criteria for Judging

Mechanics

- Contender(s) should be bona fide resident(s) of Malaybalay City.
- Age must be 15-30 years old.
- Could be in solo or in group having 3-10 members, either mixed with male and female, all male or all female groups.
- Materials and props deemed to be harmful to the participants and to the spectators are not allowed.
- The group may perform any genre of dance provided that it will not exceed 4 minutes. Any laps on the time limit will be corresponded by a point(s) deduction.

Criteria for Judging

•	Uniqueness	20%
•	Execution - Smoothness of the transition from one step pattern to another - Body movements and coordination	30%
•	Choreography and Style - Coordination between members - Design of the dance piece - Blocking - Level of difficulties	30%
•	Appearance	10%
•	Audience Impact	10%

Singing Acts Mechanics and Criteria for Judging

Mechanics

- Should be bona fide resident(s) of Malaybalay City.
- Age must be 15-30 years old.
- Could be in solo, duet or group with a maximum of 5 members.
