CHANGES IN DEPED MEMORANDUM 149, s. 2016
(2016 Annual 18-Day Campaign to End Violence Against Women and Children)

1. The **2016 Annual 18-Day Campaign to End Violence Against Women and Children** was announced through DepEd Memorandum No. 149, s. 2016. However, the following changes have been made:

- a. The theme of the 2016 Annual 18-Day Campaign *Violence Free Community Starts With Me*, is changed to *VAWC-Free Community Starts with Me*,
- b. The objectives of the Campaign are also changed to read as follows:
 - i. highlight everyone's commitment and contributions in achieving a VAWC-Free community;
 - ii. increase awareness in addressing violence against women; and
 - iii. encourage more people to participate and commit to pursuing the common vision of a VAWC-Free community.
- c. Expenses relative to the Campaign shall be charged to the respective Gender and Development (GAD) Funds of the implementing units, while expenses of the activities conducted in the Central Office shall be charged to the GAD Funds of the National Educators Academy of the Philippines-Central Office (NEAP-CO), subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations;
- d. Regional offices are expected to submit a consolidated report of all activities conducted during the Campaign period on or before December 23, 2016 to **John Arnold S. Siena**, Director IV, National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP), 2nd Floor, Mabini Building, Department of Education (DepEd) Central Office, DepEd Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City, at telefax nos.
