Pursuant to the DepEd Order 24, s. 2015 re: "Guidelines on the Implementation of Bottom-Up Budgeting Projects", the DepEd is one of the participating agencies in the implementation of Bottom-Up-Budgeting (BUB). Thus activity will enable the learner participants to be enriched with knowledge and skills that they may not encounter in the ordinary ALS Learning sessions.
