MEA/MEPA IN DEPED X

- 1. One of the major thrusts of DepEd 10 is to strengthen its capacity in Monitoring and Evaluation (M & E). The M & E system is seen as a critical support process to improving delivery of basic education services through provision of timely and accurate information. DepEd Region 10 needs immediate feedback on the efficiency of its programs, make timely improvements concerning policies and systems that affect schooling of learners.
- 2. In line with the aforementioned thrusts, DepEd 10 is poised to conduct the the 2nd Quarter Regional Monitoring, Evaluation and Plan Adjustment (RMEPA) Conference adopting the enhanced Monitoring, Evaluation and Adjustment (MEA) Technology as a feedback and sharing mechanism and as a venue for discussing alternatives between and among the Region, Schools Divisions and Schools.
- 3. At the end of the activity the following objectives should be accomplished:
 - 3.1. Reviewed the basic M & E concepts, principles and tools with the Senior Education Program Specialists (SEPS) of the Fourteen (14) Divisions and the Quality Assurance Division (QuAd) of DepEd 10;
 - 3.2 Revisited the objectives, mechanics, processes and requirements of the proposed Enhance MEA/MEPA technology with the Fourteen (14) School Division Offices and Quality Assurance Division (QuAd) of DepEd 10 Office.
 - 3.3 Enabled the Department of Education staff to identify and agree on the next steps involved leading to the actual conduct of the MEA/MEPA in the region; and
 - 3.4. Implement the 2nd Quarter MEA/MEPA conference of the Fourteen (14) Schools Division Offices.
