

Section 23 of Republic Act No. 10742 (Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015), states that there shall be in every province, city and municipality a Local Youth Development Council (LYDC); in this regard, the city created the Malaybalay City Local Youth Development Council. Henna/Mehandi Tattoo Competition

Mechanics/Guidelines:

- 1. Must be bona fide resident of Malaybalay City.
- 2. Age must be 15-30 years old.
- 3. Contestants must create their henna individually, not as a team with other artists.
- 4. Hennas must have a theme of Tribal Culture of Malaybalay City and/or Bukidpon.
- 5. Materials and equipment to be used during the competition must be provided by the participants.
- 6. Participants may use different colours of inks.
- 7. Participants will apply the henna at another persons' body, they will be the one to bring that person at the venue.
- 8. Hennas must be applied at the left arm, or at the right arm, or at the back of another person.
- 9. All hennas entered into the contest must be performed by the artist in attendance at the event.
- 10. Participants are not allowed to use any design book as reference or any kind of such material during the contest.
- 11. There shall be no specific size of the henna.
- 12. Participants will have a maximum of 3 hours (9am to 12 noon) to complete the penna.
- 13 Judging is done on a points scale basis by 2 Judges.
- 14. There must be a registration fee of 100 pesos per contestant.
- 15. There will be **3 winners**, **1**st (**3,000** pesos cash + trophy + certificate), 2^{nq} (**2,000** pesos cash + trophy + certificate), and 3^{rd} (**1,000** pesos cash + trophy + certificate).
- 16. The organizers reserve the right to amend the mechanics and guidelines stated.
- 17. Failure to comply with the stated guidelines will result to disqualification.

Criteria for Judging:

- 1. Creativity
- 2. Relevance to the Theme
- Neatness
- 4. Complexity and Detail of the design

Soil Painting Competition

Mechanics/Guidelines:

- 1. Must be bona fide resident of Malaybalay City
- 2. Age must be 15-30 years old.
- 3. The art must have a theme of Tribal Culture of Malaybalay City and/or Bukldnon.
- 4. Contestants must create their art individually, not as a team with other artists
- 5. Materials and equipment to be used during the competition must be provided by the participants.
- Participants can use any size of canvass.
- Participants may use different colours of soil.
- 8. All art piece entered into the contest must be performed by the artists in attendance at the event.
- 9. Participants will have a maximum of 3 hours (9am to 12 noon) to complete the art.
- 10. Judging is done on a points scale basis by 1 Judge.
- 11. There must be a registration fee of 100 pesos per contestant.
- 12 There will be **3 winners**, **1**st (**3,000** pesos cash + trophy + certificate), **3**rd (**2,000** pesos cash + trophy certificate), and **3**rd (**1,000** pesos cash + trophy certificate).
- 13. The organizers reserve the right to amend the mechanics and guidelines stated.
- 14. Failure to comply with the stated guidelines will result to disqualification.

Criteria for Judging:

- 1. Relevance to the theme
- 2. Creativity
- 3. Overall Impression of the Art

Battle of the Bands (Binukid)

Mechanics Guidelines:

- 1. Must be **bona fide** residents of Malaybalay City.
- 2. Members must be composed of ages 15-30 years old only. No limit on the number of members.
- 3. Participants must play Binukid Songs.
- 4. Modernized tribal song is not allowed.
- 5. Participants may create their **original tribal song**, must use *Binukid* dialects.
- 6. Songs must be performed live. Pre-recorded accompaniment is not allowed.
- Participants will perform 2 songs.
- 8. The bands must play their songs within 15 minutes, 3 points deduction from the total score if exceeds the 15 minute limit.
- 9. Participants should bring their own musical instruments.

- 40. Judging is done on a points scale basis by 3 Judges.
- 11. There must be a **registration fee** of 250 pesos per band.
 - 12. **Sequence of performances** will be based on the pre-registration, those who pre-registered first will be the first to perform.
- 13. There will be 3 winners, 1st (10,000 pesos cash ± trophy ± certificate), 1nd (7,000 pesos cash ± trophy ± certificate), and 3rd (5,000 pesos cash ± trophy ± certificate).
- 14. The organizers reserve the right to amend the mechanics and guidelines stated.
- 15. Failure to comply with the stated guidelines will result to disqualification.

Criteria for Judging:

1. Musicality Lyrics	40%
2. Stage performance	30%
3. Audience Impact	30%

Cultural Dance Competition (Contest of dance based on the local cultura of Malaybalay City and/or Bukidnon)

Mechanics/Guidelines:

- 1. Must be bona fide residents of Malaybalay City.
- 2. Members must be composed of ages 15-30 years old only.
- 3. Dance piece should depict the tribal culture of Malaybalay City and/or Bukidnon.
- 4. Modernized cultural dance is not allowed.
- 5. The group must be **composed of 6-20 dancers**.
- 6. The performance must be at least 5 minutes but must not exceed 7 minutes. A 3 points deduction from the total score if the performance exceeded 7 minutes.
- 7. Materials and props **deemed to be harmful** to the participants and to the spectators are **not allowed** (real fighting equipment, any form of liquid, fire, etc.). Use of **living animals** is also prohibited.
- 8. No dancer is allowed to dance in more than one group.
- 9. The group may use pre-recorded musical accompaniment and/or perform live musical instruments.
- 10. All pre-recorded musical accompaniment must be submitted to the organizers upon registration at the venue.
- 11. **Sequence of performances** will be based on the pre-registration, those who pre-registered first will be the first to perform
- 12. Judging is done on a points scale basis by 3 Judges.
- 13. There must be a **registration fee** of 500 pesos per group.
- 14. There will be 3 winners, 1^{st} (15,000 pesos cash ± trophy ± certificate), $2^{\dagger d}$ (12,000 pesos cash ± trophy ± certificate), and 3^{rd} (10,000 pesos cash ± trophy ± certificate).
- 15. The organizers reserve the right to amend the mechanics and guidelines stated.
- 16. Failure to comply with the stated guidelines will result to disqualification.

Criteria for Judging:

1.	Mastery/Appropriateness	30%
2.	Authenticity/Originality	30%
3.	Stage Presence	20%
4.	Costumes and Props	20%

Parade and Overall Participation Contest

Mechanics/Guidelines:

- 1. Must be bona fide residents of Malaybalay City.
- 2. Each institution/organization must have their banners.
- 3. Must arrive at the parade assembly area on or before the assembly time.
- 4. Participants may utter chants or cheers.
- 5. The contest will be judged by several persons stationed during the entirety of the event.
- 6. There will be 3 winners, 1^{st} (5,000 pesos cash \pm trophy \pm certificate), 2^{tot} (4,000 pesos cash \pm trophy \pm certificate), and 3^{rd} (3,000 pesos cash \pm trophy \pm certificate).
- 7. The organizers reserve the right to amend the mechanics and guidelines stated.

Criteria for Judging:

- Early Bird
- 2. Most Organized
- 3. Most Appealing during the parade
- 4. Most beautiful banner
- 5 Most Prepared
- 6. Most Participative during the event
- 7. Most Intact during the event until its conclusion
