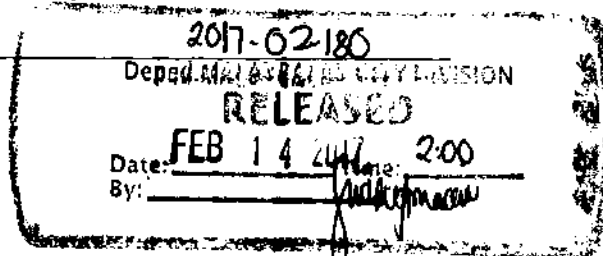

ADMINISTRATION OF THE 2017 NATIONAL CAREER ASSESSMENT EXAMINATION (NCAE) AND UTILIZATION OF RESULTS THEREIN

To: Schools Division Superintendents
This Region

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 16, s. 2017, the 2017 National Career Assessment Examination (NCAE) shall be administered from March 1 - 2, 2017 to all Grade 9 students in both public and private schools nationwide.
2. The conduct of the NCAE is to provide guidance to individual learners for their future educational and career choices and to provide basis for profiling learners' aptitude in the Senior High School tracks.
3. The Career Assessment which shall be applicable for both regular learners and learners with special needs will cover the following domains:
 - a. General Scholastic Aptitude (GSA)
 - b. Occupational Interest Inventory (OII)
 - c. Aptitude for Senior High School (SHS) Tracks
4. The results to be released in another issuance shall be used in career advocacy, career guidance and homeroom guidance. Per DepEd Order No. 55, s. 2016, results shall be used for entry assessment to the specific Senior High School (SHS) tracks/strands in all public and private schools reiterating the following:
 - a. Learners who wish to enroll in the Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) Strand should have at least a percentile rank of 86 and above in the STEM subtest in the career assessment examination in addition to their Final Grade both in Science and Mathematics in Grade 10 which should be 85 and above.

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- b. Learners who wish to enroll in the Sports and Arts and Design Tracks should have at least a percentile rank of 51 above in the career assessment in addition to skills-related fitness tests and skills assessment which will also be administered by the accepting schools, respectively.
 - c. Learners who desire to enter into the Humanities and Social Science (HUMSS) Strand, the Accountancy, Business and Management (ABM) Strand, and the Technical- Vocational and Livelihood (TVL) Track have no prescribed cut-off scores in any subtest of the NCAE.
5. An orientation shall be conducted by the school through the Guidance Counselor or designated guidance coordinator to inform them of the test results and the in-demand and hard-to-fill occupations by industry per region to guide them in the track or course for senior high school.
