1. As a manifestation of its strong support in strengthening the government's anti-illegal drugs program and the **National Drug Education Program (NDEP)**, this Office hereby informs everyone re: **Creation of the Department of Education Drug –Free Workplace Committee.** The committee shall undertake the duties and responsibilities of the **Department**'s anti-drug abuse program and policy. - 2. Paragraph 6 in the Memorandum states that the Workplace shall cover the entire Department of Education, including the Central Office, Regional Offices, Schools Division Offices, schools and all other units with its officers, teaching and non-teaching personnel, contract of service an job order employees, regardless of rank, status and salary.

CREATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE COMMITTEE

- 1. Under Republic Act (RA) No. 9165, otherwise known as the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002, it is the policy of the State to safeguard the integrity of its territory and the well-being of its citizenry, particularly the youth, from the harmful effects of dangerous drugs on their physical and mental well-being, and to defend the same against acts or omissions detrimental to their development and preservation. Towards this end, the government shall pursue an intensive and unrelenting campaign against the trafficking and use of dangerous drugs, and other similar substances through an integrated system of planning, implementation and enforcement of antidrug abuse policies, programs, and projects.
- 2. The Department of Education is committed to strengthen its programs on antiillegal drugs by complementing its existing National Drug Education Program (NDEP) with a comprehensive policy against drug abuse in the workplace, as mandated by the Dangerous Drugs Board Regulation No. 2, s. 2004.
- 3. In view of the foregoing, the Department hereby creates a **Drug-Free Workplace Committee**, with the following members:

 Organizational Development (BHROD)
- d. Schools Division Suprerintendent duly designated by the Philippine Association of School Superintendents (PASS)
- e. Dr. Maria Corazon C. Dumlao, Chief School Health Division, BLSS
- f. Duly designated representative of National Employees' Union
- g. Duly designated representative of the Alliance of Concerned Teachers

- 4. The Committee shall undertake the following duties and responsibilities:
 - a. Oversee the formulation and implementation of the anti-drug abuse policy in the Department;
 - b. Initiate training and continuing education and awareness program for officers and employees;
 - c. Initiate and adopt value formation, family enhancement and such other related and relevant programs; and
 - d. Formulate and put in place the Department's Drug Testing Program which shall be in accordance with pertinent provisions of RA 9165 and pertinent regulations.
- 5. The following officers are designated to constitute the Secretariat of the Committee:
 - a. Dir. Demetria L. Manuel, Director III, Special Concerns Unit;
 - b. Atty. Clifford C. Chan, Attorney IV, Investigation Division, Legal Service;
 - c. Duly designated personnel from the Planning Service; and
 - d. Duly designated personnel from the Personnel Division, Employees Welfare Division, and BHROD.
- 6. The Secretariat shall be responsible for assisting the *Drug-Free Workplace Committee*, coordinating its efforts, and keeping records of meetings.
- 7. Workplace shall cover the entire Department of Education, including the Central Office, Regional Offices, Schools Division Offices, schools and all other units, with all its officers, teaching and non-teaching personnel, contract of service and job order employees, regardless of rank, status, and salary.
- 8. The Committee shall immediately convene upon issuance of this Memorandum and shall regularly report its work to the Secretary of the Department.
- 9. The Office of the Secretary shall allocate adequate funds for the operations of the Committee and the implementation of its programs, subject to availability of funds and the usual accounting and auditing laws, rules, and regulations.
- 10. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
