

THE DISTRIBUTION OF PENCILS FROM THE ONE MILLION LAPIS CAMPAIGN

#### GUIDELINES ON THE DISTRIBUTION OF PENCILS COLLECTED FROM THE ONE MILLION LAPIS CAMPAIGN

To: Regional Secretary, ARMM
Regional Directors
Schools Division Superintendents

All Others Concerned

- 1. The Council for the Welfare of Children (CWC) launched the **One Million** Lapis Campaign in November 2016 as one of the major activities of the National Children's Month. The project aims to collect one million pencils to be distributed to underprivileged Grades 1 to 3 pupils in public elementary schools from the 4th to 6th class municipalities in the Philippines. The campaign also envisions to set a record for the longest line of pencils in the Guinness Book of World Records.
- 2. In support to this project, the Department of Education (DepEd) issued DepEd Memorandum No. 169, s. 2016 entitled *One Million Lapis Campaign* to encourage all DepEd offices, including the central office (CO) and all regional and schools division offices, as well as all public and private schools to participate in the campaign. Moreover, DepEd has designated a Regional Partnership Focal Person (RPFP) in every regional office (RO) to lead in the dissemination of the campaign and to monitor the collection of pencils.
- 3. As of January 31, 2017, the CWC has turned-over to DepEd a total of 2,768,880 pencils collected from donors from private/business establishments, government agencies, government owned and controlled corporations, nongovernment organizations, and the academe. The breakdown is provided in Enclosure No. 1.
- 4. The DepEd External Partnerships Service (EPS) has sourced the following data on the number of pupils from public schools belonging to the 4th to 6th class municipalities. These pupils shall be the recipients of pencils collected from the campaign:

- 5. The list of recipient schools and number of students per grade level is contained in Enclosure No. 2.
- The RPFP shall:
  - a. report to the EPS the total number of pencils collected in their respective regions using the Monitoring Form provided in Enclosure No. 3;
  - b. validate with the EPS the list of recipient schools in their regions and the number of Grades 1-3 pupils in each school;
  - c. take the lead in the distribution of pencils collected from the campaign; and
  - d. ensure that the pencils will be distributed to the appropriate recipient schools and pupils.
- 7. Pupil-recipients shall receive six pencils each.
- 8. Since the pencils collected in the RO are stored in their respective offices, each RO shall be responsible in the distribution of pencils to their recipient learners based on the given list. The DepEd CO shall add the number of pencils needed in order to comply with their requirements, if necessary. In case some ROs will have excess pencils, they may opt to distribute them to other recipients in their respective regions.
- 9. The pencils collected from the campaign shall be delivered or picked up from the CO to the ROs from March to May 2017.
- 10. The ceremonial turnover of pencils to the ROs shall be held during the Regional Kick-Off of the *Brigada Eskwela* in May 2017, in time for the opening of classes in June 2017.
- 11. The RPFPs shall submit the following documents to the EPS upon completion of the distribution of pencils on or before **July 7, 2017**:
  - a. Acknowledgement Receipt signed by the regional director;
  - List of recipient schools and date of turn-over/delivery of pencils to schools;
     and
  - c. Photos of the turnover ceremony, delivery of pencils, and distribution of pencils to the pupils.
- 12. The said documents shall be addressed to **Dr. Margarita Consolacion C.
