


To: Schools Division Superintendents

This Region

1. Pursuant to RA 10533 otherwise known as the Enhanced Basic Education Program, this Office reaffirms its commitment by holding a K to 12 Conference on Cum Commitment Signing of the Regional Education Development Plan on March 31, 2017 to April 1, 2017. The venue for the conduct of the K to 12 Conference shall be at Koresco Hotel, Pueblo de Oro Golf, Lumbia, Cagayan de Oro City while the Signing of the Regional Education Development Plan and Division Education Development Plan shall be held at Xavier Sports Country Club, Xavier Estates, Upper Balulang, Cagayan de Oro City.

2. The conference aims to:

- a. present latest issues, challenges and interventions in the implementation of K to 12 programs;
- b. highlight the best practices and share experiences and strategies in implementing the K to 12 curriculum;
- c. present quality management system in handling school credentials and data management to include voucher system of K to 12:
- d. discuss issues on localization and indigenization of knowledge, skills and resources applicable to geographical location of K to 12 implementers; and
- e. apply K to 12 innovative approaches/insights/best practices to different regional/division contexts of K to 12 programs.
- 3. The conference is divided into four (4) blocks, each with its own theme. These themes are:
 - a. Kinder to grade 6: Best Practices in the Implementation of Inclusive Education;



- b. Junior High School: Best Practices in the Implementation of Inclusive Education:
