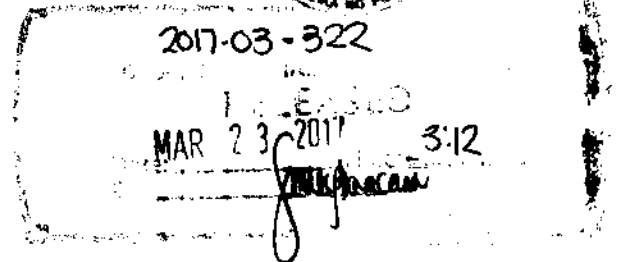

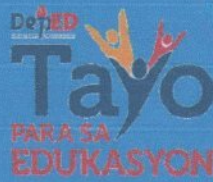


MESSAGE
