

Re: SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON THE ICT4ED SUSTAINABILITY FOR RE-ENTRY PROJECT (REP) "ICT4ED: THE HIGH TECH TEACHERS IN MALAYBALAY CITY

- To ensure the sustainability of the implementation of the Re-Entry Project (ReP) entitled, "ICT4Ed: The High Tech Teachers in Malaybalay City", this Office will conduct a seminar-workshop on the ICT4Ed Project sustainability on May 9, 2017 from 7:30am to 5:00pm at a venue to be announced later.
- 2. The seminar-workshop aims to:
 - Orient participants on the status of the ReP during the 3-month implementation period;
 - Provide participants on the approved copies of the ReP deliverables for their use in implementing and sustaining the ReP at the school-level;
 - Recognize concerned participants who contributed to the accomplishment of the ReP deliverables;
 - Capacitate them on how to develop an Integrated ICT4Ed Project Sustainability
 Work Plan at the school level; and,
 - Require them to present, revise, and submit their Integrated ICT4Ed Project Sustainability Work Plan to the Office through the Division ICT4Ed Project Team.
- 3. The participants of this activity are the Elementary and Secondary School Heads and School ICT Coordinators. School Heads who are on official business should send a representative to the above-mentioned activity. Further, each school is required to bring one (1) laptop & extension wire.
- Teacher participants shall be entitled to a one (1) day service credit in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 dated June 24, 2003 re: Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers.

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5. Transportation and other related expenses of the participants shall be charged against School MOOE/ local Fund while meals, snacks, and training materials shall be charged to Division HRTD Fund subject to the existing accounting and auditing policies, rules and regulations.
