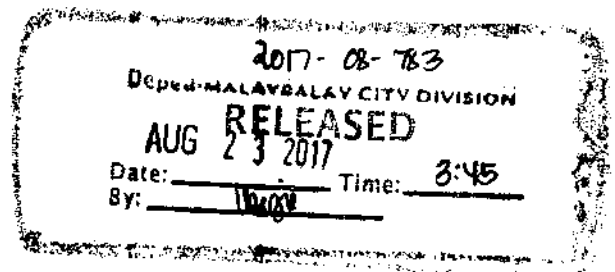

2. The Division Festival objectives:

- a. Discover, nurture and develop talents of learners and teachers in all learning disciplines to raise academic performance particularly in Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) and Technical Vocational Livelihood (TVL) courses;
- b. Serve as a vehicle for promotion of programs and projects implemented by Deped;
- c. Encourage Filipino citizens to take active responsibility for the holistic development of learners and teachers; and
- d. Develop and strengthen cooperation and partnership between and among various sectors of the society.

3. Participants to this festival are the first place winners during the District Level Technolympics/Depednomics skills competition both elementary, Alternative Learning System (ALS), Junior and Senior High school, coaches, members of the working committees, contest administrator school heads and Public Schools District Supervisors.

4. Only the first place winners in the technolympics will represent DepEd Division of Malaybalay City to the regional level which the date and venue will be announced soon, excluding the Division initiated competitions.

5. The list of skills to be contested, contest packages and criteria for judging will be provided by Mr. Luis S. Alajar Jr, EPS in EPP/TLE/TVE with contact No. 09173114505.

6. Registration fee of One Hundred Fifty pesos (Php.150.00) shall be collected from the contest participants and teacher-coaches for the certificates, medals, trophies and snacks of judges, contest administrators, working committees and other expenses might be charged against EPP/TLE/TVL, school GPTA, IGP, canteen and other funds. While, meals and snacks, contest materials, and other incidental expenses of contest participants and coaches will be charged against school MOOE, canteen, GPTA and other funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

I. General Guidelines in the 2017 Division Festival of Talents in Technolympics and DepEdnomics:

1. There are twelve (12) skills to be contested in the Technolympics and Nine (9) in DepEdnomics excluding Division Initiated Competitions.
2. Contests are designed for elementary, ALS, junior and senior high schools provided with the skills guidelines, criteria and procedures. Private schools are welcome and encouraged to participate.
3. All contest materials and tools/equipment shall be provided by the contestant. Borrowing of tools, equipment and contest materials during the contest is not allowed.
4. All contestants shall be at the contest venue 15 minutes before the start of the contest.
5. Contestant's credible records/documents are the responsibility of the coach and the school heads.
6. Only the Division First place winner that will represent the regional skills contest shall prepare documents.
7. Preferably the EPP/TLE/TVL teacher shall be the coach for the skills contest. However, non-TLE/TVL teacher from small schools may coach at the division level search. In case the contestant wins, the TLE/TVL teacher from the same school shall take over the coach at the regional level skills competition.
8. Contest administrators shall ensure the smooth conduct of the contest assigned to them. The contestants shall be oriented properly rather than the coaches.
9. The coach shall not be staying at the contest venue especially when the contest is in progress.
10. The board of judges will be from line agencies and expert teachers from the elementary schools. Their decisions will be final.
11. The contest package for every contest in technolympics skills competition is based on the 2017 National Technolympics contest package. The rest of the contests that are not found in the Memorandum shall be referred to the Education Program Supervisor in EPP/TLE/TVL.
12. Wearing of school uniform is allowed during the contest. However, if the contestant can afford to wear Maong Pants with Plain White T-Shirt with no school identifying marks is more appreciated.
13. In determining the over-all champions, the points system (10-7-5-3 & 20 shall be computed for 1st up to 5th place. Non-winning school with participation will automatically be given with one (1) point.
14. There shall be three (3) winners for each skill contest. Only the first place winner in the technolympics (except division initiated) will represent this division to the regional level skills competition.
15. In case of first place winner/s from the private school/s, they should participate to the higher competitions.
16. Winning contestants will receive medals, coaches will receive certificates and Trophies for the over-all results.
17. No questions shall be entertained during the contest proper except clarifications and point of order. All clarifications and points of order shall be raised with the event administrator.
18. The working area should be cleaned immediately after every event.
19. All results and outputs shall be endorsed to the Secretariat by the event administrator.
20. All endorsed outputs shall be displayed throughout the duration of the event.
