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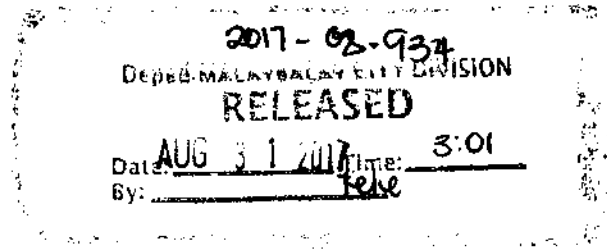

**INTEGRATION OF NATIONAL DRUG EDUCATION PROGRAM (NDEP)  
TO THE ENHANCED BASIC EDUCATION CURRICULUM**

**To: Schools Division Superintendents**  
*This Region*

1. Pursuant to DepED Memorandum No. 200, s. 2016 otherwise known as *Strengthening the National Drug Education Program in Schools*, curriculum and instruction is one of the five components of NDEP to create awareness on the ill effects of abusing drugs and to develop among pupils' and students' positive behavior and life skills to resist drugs.
2. For this reason, this Office reiterates the integration of NDEP to the Enhanced Basic Education Curriculum by contextualizing third quarter learning competencies in all learning areas from Grades 4 to 12 to ensure the inclusion of drug education in the teaching and learning activities in schools.
3. Each Schools Division is requested to develop and submit sixty (60) detailed lesson plans for drug education using the format prescribed in the DepED Order 42, s. 2016 with the following parts: Objectives, Content (with specific content standards, performance standards and learning competency), Learning Resources, Procedures, Remarks and Reflection. Enclosed is the specific number of DLP by learning area and by grade level.
4. It is expected that the Division Education Supervisors and Division LRMS Coordinator will evaluate and finalize the DLP prepared by teachers for consolidation and submission to the Regional Office on September 29, 2017 for uploading in the DepED Learning Resource Portal.
